





Stechford to Aston (SAS13) Bridge Replacement

On behalf of HS2, Network Rail and Skanska are replacing the Stechford to Aston (SAS13) Bridge in your area with a new bridge which will pave the way for high-speed trains to travel to Birmingham City Centre.

The new SAS13 bridge will be the longest single span bridge in the Midlands and one of the largest in the UK. We informed you about our plans to demolish the existing Stechford to Aston (SAS13) bridge last year, which took place in Autumn 2021.

We're now building the replacement bridge which, when completed, will weigh 24,000 tonnes and measure 93.35 metres in length. This new bridge will be completed in April and will be lifted into place in May 2022 using one of the largest cranes in the UK.
