High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What are we doing?

In order to prepare for the future Interchange Station and railway, Western Power Distribution need to carry out work on the A452 Chester Road outside Melbicks Garden Centre. The work will include excavating in the Southbound carriageway verge.

In order to undertake the work safely a southbound lane closure on A452 Chester Road will be in place from 7pm until 6am between Monday 14 March and Thursday 31 March 2022.

Additionally, temporary overnight closures of the southbound carriageway will be in place for two nights from 8pm until 6am on Tuesday 29th and Wednesday 30th March 2022.

Maps showing the location of the works are on pages 2 and 3 of this notice.

How will this impact you?

Western Power Distribution has a responsibility for delivering electricity services to homes and businesses across the region, and will ensure that the impact of any work is kept to a minimum.

Where required, diversionary routes will be fully signed for road users.

We are continually reviewing the work on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current COVID-19 strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. - We will be on-site one hour either side of these times for set-up and close-down

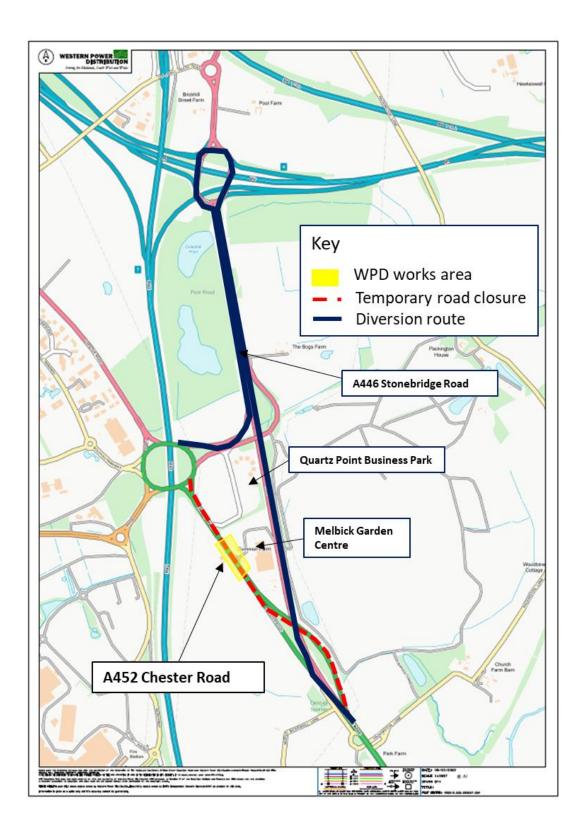
What to expect

- Every endeavour will be made to keep disruption to a minimum.

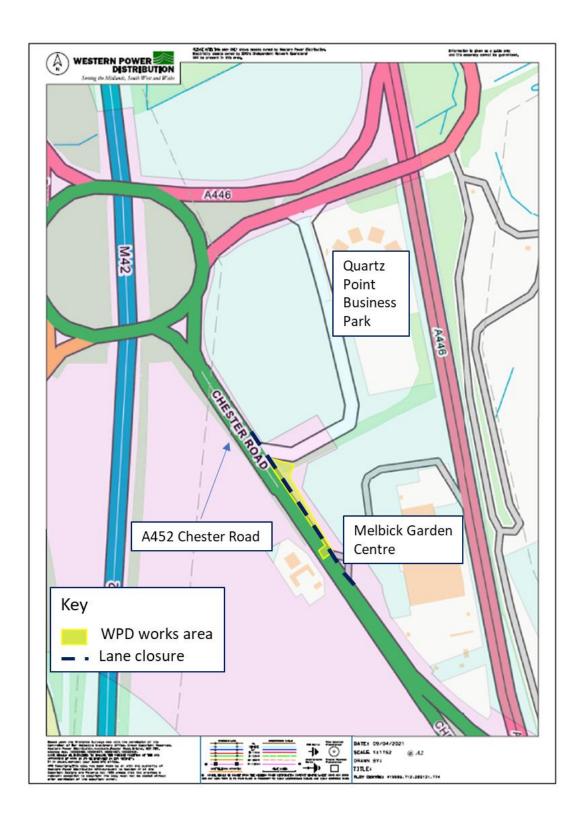
What we will do
