Notice of off-peak traffic measures along the M42 and A446 from March to May 2022

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

We're preparing for the future railway construction

As part of our preparation works for the future construction of the HS2 Interchange Station and railway route we are carrying out roadside landscaping and construction activities along carriageways in the area. To ensure safe access to our work sites to carry out these activities, we will install traffic measures when necessary.

Overnight M42 hard shoulder closure in March

We'll install a temporary overnight hard shoulder closure along a short section of the M42 northbound, leading into a lane closure on the M42 J7 and M6 link road, from **10pm on Wednesday 2 March to 6am on Thursday 3 March** (see map on page 2). Clear signage will be placed along the route to assist road users.

Off-peak A446 lane closure from March to May

We'll install a temporary off-peak single lane closure along a short section of the A446 southbound from **Tuesday 1 March to Tuesday 31 May**, between **9.30am and 3.30pm**, Monday to Friday (see map on page 3). This lane closure will not be in place every day during this period, but instead will be installed when required by our programme to avoid overburdening the road network.

The A446 southbound single lane closure will not be installed from 6am on Thursday 14 April to 9.30am on Tuesday 19 April, and Monday 2 May, to ease traffic flow during the public holidays.

Overnight hard shoulder closure along the M42 northbound in March.

Off-peak lane closure along the A446 southbound from March to May.

What to expect

This work is subject to change.

Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after these times to set up and close down the site.

Leave the area in a tidy state when works are complete.

Maintain access to all buildings and businesses in the area.

Install clear directional signage for road users.




Location of overnight M42 hard shoulder closure in March




Location of off-peak A446 lane closure from March to May
