

# A452 Kenilworth Road - roundabout construction

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high-speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.



Please find below further dates for traffic management to support the construction of the roundabout on the A452 Kenilworth Road, Berkswell, close to Park Lane.

#### What to expect

**7, 8 & 9 March**: Overnight road closures on the <u>northbound</u> <u>carriageway</u> 8pm to 6am. **Wootton Lane will remain closed from the A452. Please follow diversion.** 

**10, 11, 12 & 13 March** - Overnight road closures on the southbound carriageway 8pm to 6am. **Park Lane access will be closed from the A452. Please follow diversion.** 

**Ongoing until further notice:** Single lane closures on both carriageways 24/7 with daytime working hours.

Traffic management, including all signage, will be erected as and when required subject to consent, site and weather conditions. Please keep an eye out for signage on the road as dates are also subject to change.

#### **Further information**

**Local diversions will be clearly signposted.** Access for residents and businesses within the A452 closure will be maintained by approaching the traffic marshall at the relevant closure point. **For live up-to-date traffic information and diversion routes please go to one.network.** For more information about works in your area please register with **www.hs2insolihull.co.uk**

A452 overnight road closures - 8pm to 6am.

Daytime working hours under lane closures -Mon to Fri 8am to 6pm Sat 8am to 1pm

Our contractors may also be on site for up to one hour beforehand and after to set up and pack up the site.

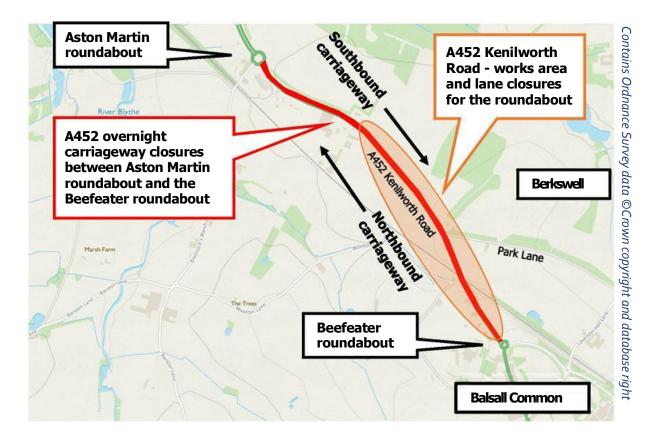
