



Updated notice of traffic management Wood End Lane, Fradley

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we are doing

We will be constructing new junctions and access points on Wood End Lane to connect our haul roads, minimising disruption where possible by taking HS2 traffic off the roads.

We will also be undertaking surveys to identify the location of existing utility services below ground level. The surveys will allow us to record and mitigate any impacts, on these utilities, from future construction works. Surveys being undertaken in location 2 will require machinery, to dig the ground along the grass verge. For the safety of both our workforce and road users, we will install lane closures and temporary traffic lights to manage traffic flow.

When will these works take place

Due to adverse weather conditions and to accommodate for the Easter period, we have changed our programme of construction activities on Wood End Lane.

Our activities will take place in four locations along Wood End Lane, which we have detailed on a map on the next page.

- Location 1: From 14 March until 8 April between 8am and 6pm
- Location 2: From 21 March until 25 March between 8am and 4pm
- Location 3: From 19 April to 20 May between 8am and 6pm
- Location 4: From 25 May to 25 June between 8am and 6pm

Access to properties will always be maintained. Our workforce can be on site one hour before and after to set up and secure our equipment.

Duration of works

Location 1: From 14 March until 8 April

Location 2: From 21 March until 25 March

Location 3: From 19 April to 20 May

Location 4: From 25 May to 25 June

Our working hours will be 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday, apart from at location 2 where we will work until 4pm.

Please note these works maybe subject to change.

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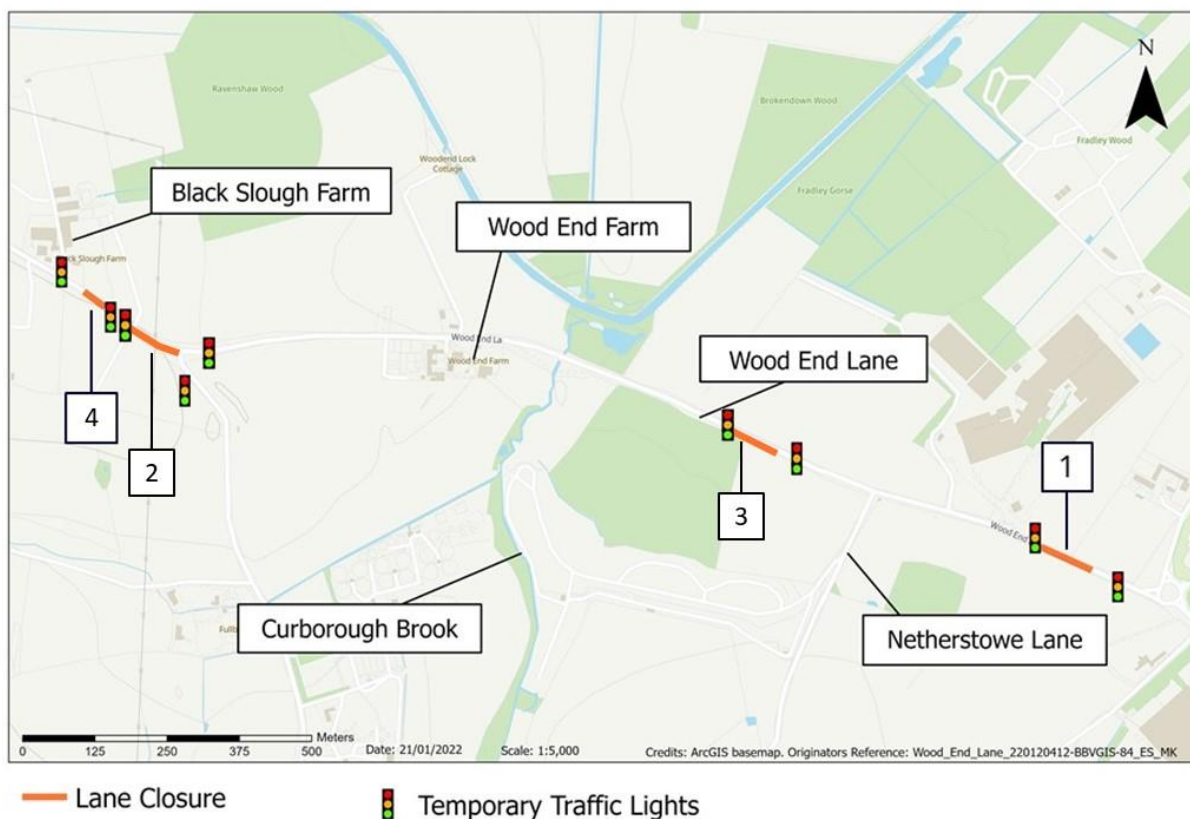

Temporary lane closures with traffic lights Wood End Lane.

Temporary traffic lights will be in use for 24 hours a day and seven days a week at location 1, with use of the footpath affected and diverted safely onto the road where the lane closure is in place.

At location 2, three-way temporary traffic lights will be in use from 8am until 4pm each day.

Temporary traffic lights locations 3 and 4 will be in use during the hours of 8am until 6pm.

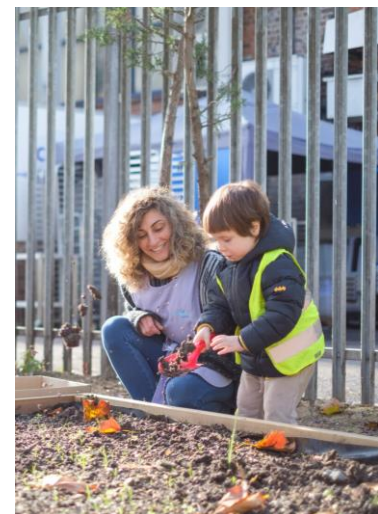
About our Community and Business Funds
