



Notice of works, A418, Oxford Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review. What are we doing?

In late March, we will be carrying out some road repairs along the A418 Oxford Road. These works will require temporary traffic management in the form of a lane closure with two-way traffic lights.

We will also be carrying out drainage works on the A418 Oxford Road. A camera will be used to investigate and survey the condition of the drainage system. This will help us to understand how best to protect the drainage while we build HS2.

Our works will be carried out under traffic management, in the form of a lane closure with two-way traffic lights. To further reduce the inconvenience to road users, traffic management will only be introduced overnight.

We realise that previous CCTV drainage surveys which were carried out required strong jet washing to remove blockages in the local drain network. This resulted in some loud noise which may have caused disruptions throughout the day. These survey works will not include any jet washing.

When will these works take place?

The A418 Oxford Road will have temporary traffic management in the form of a lane closure with two-way traffic lights on Saturday 26 March from 8.00am to 1.00pm.

There will also be temporary traffic management on the A418 Oxford Road overnight from 10.00pm to 5.00am, Monday 28 March to Friday 1 April 2022.

Works will commence Saturday 26 March 2022 and are expected to be complete by Friday 1 April 2022.

Saturday working hours:
8.00am – 1.00pm

Overnight working hours:
Monday to Friday
10.00pm – 5.00am

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

There may be a short duration outside of these times to allow for the set-up of road signage and traffic lights.

Where will the works take place?

The map below, shows the section of the A418 that will have traffic management.

Traffic equipment may remain in place on the roadside when lane or road closures are not operational to allow for reduced set up time and minimise delays.

There may be a short duration outside of the advertised times to allow for our traffic management crews to set-up or take-down road signage and traffic equipment. Lane closures will not be operational during these times, however you may see our crews setting up within the highway.
