

Notice of weekend road closures on and around Northway Island in April

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are being carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons, known as LM. In your area, we are working near the A452, A45 and M42, which surround the site of the future HS2 Interchange Station.

We're improving the local road network

We are remodelling and improving sections of the existing road network in the area and creating new routes on HS2 land. These road improvements will ensure that when the future station is operational, the local road network is fit for purpose. Upon completion, a new T-junction will replace Northway Island. A new 'longabout' is already in operation outside the Holiday Inn Express NEC, on the way to the National Exhibition Centre (NEC).

We started the creation of the new T-junction in April 2021. To enable us to connect parts of the existing road network, to the new routes we have created, a series of weekend road closures have been installed in 2022 on and around Northway Island. We will conclude this programme by installing a final weekend closure in April 2022.

We'll be installing a weekend road closure in April

We will install a temporary, weekend road closure around parts of Northway Island, and along short sections of the B4438 northbound and A452 northbound and southbound from **6am on Saturday 9 April through to 5am on Monday 11 April** (see map on page 2).

A signed diversion route will be in place for road users during both weekend road closures. If work progresses faster than expected, we will reopen all routes earlier if possible.

Duration of works

From 6am on Saturday 9 April through to 5am on Monday 11 April.

What to expect

A temporary, weekend road closure on and around Northway Island.

Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after those times to set up and close down the site.

What we will do

Install signed diversion route for road users during both closures.

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Leave the area in a tidy state when works are complete.

Maintain access to all buildings and businesses in the area.

Location of temporary weekend road closure from 9 to 11 April


