Map 1 - Adelaide Road




Construction look ahead

Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Adelaide Road site	February to May 2022	Works are ongoing to set up the Adelaide Road site for future construction of the ventilation shaft and headhouse.
Road Site		 Ongoing works at this site include: Piling works to provide ground stability and support during future works to build the ventilation shaft; Installation of access gates and additional welfare facilities;
		 Installation of working platforms for future works; On-site utility connections; Installation of ground anchors;

		 Excavation works on the embankment for future works to build the ventilation shaft and headhouse; Ongoing ground investigations and utility surveys in your area; and Ongoing vegetation clearance within the site. Some extended working hours will be required during our works at the Adelaide Road site. We'll provide information to our neighbours in advance of any extended working hours.
	May 2022 to May 2023	 Works during this period will include: Ongoing installation of ground anchors; Excavation works on the embankment for future works to build the ventilation shaft and headhouse; Installation of site access road and ramp; Works to build the ventilation shaft including excavation and installation of concrete rings; Utility protection works*; and Piling works for the future headhouse. *Details of the utility protection works remain subject to ongoing ground investigations and utility design. We will provide more information about these works in advance of any utility diversion works. Some extended working hours will be required during our ongoing works at the Adelaide Road site. We'll provide information to our neighbours in advance of any extended working hours.
Various locations, Camden	February to May 2022	We will carry out utility surveys in various locations along the HS2 tunnel route. The surveys will inform future works to protect the utility services during construction of the tunnels. We may need to carry out future utility protection works in some local areas in Camden.


Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Vehicle Holding Area and Parkway	August 2021 onwards	The vehicle holding area will be in operation until 2033.
	April 2022	Ground investigations on Parkway We will carry out surveys and trial pits on Parkway, Delancey Street and Gloucester Avenue to assess the structure of the bridge. We will require traffic management for these works. For safety, some of these surveys will be carried out during extended weekend working hours, when the railway tunnels below are not in use. Parkway utility mitigation works
	2022	We will carry out works to strengthen and divert utility services beneath Parkway ahead of tunnelling.
Location 1a Park Village East north	February to April 2022	New water connections at Park Village East north to HS2 worksite along the trackside (Thames Water) These Thames Water works will take up to five weeks, with the start date to be finalised with Camden Council. Thames Water will put in place traffic management and maintain resident access.
	March to May 2022	Lorry lay-by installed on Park Village East north We will narrow the lane, close the footway and suspend parking bays to prepare our working area for the lorry lay-by. We will then close the road to install the lay-by. We need to remove several parking bays to install and operate the lorry lay-by. We will install alternative parking to replace these bays. We expect the lorry lay-by to be operational from June 2022.
	Summer 2022	Park Village East utility mitigation works We will carry out works to strengthen utility services beneath Park Village East ahead of tunnelling.

Camden Cutting	spring 2022	We are installing ground anchors along the length of the Network Rail retaining wall. The work will be done within the railway cutting. These ground anchors are not expected to have any impact on local properties.
	Ongoing until	Track-level weekend works
	April 2022	Track-level surveys, monitoring, site-preparation, and bridge strengthening works during weekend overnight hours.
		For safety, due to the proximity of the works to the tracks, these works can only be carried out overnight during the weekend when the tracks are not in use.

	autumn 2022	Piling between Parkway and Granby Terrace bridges.

Traffic management; Site set up, hoarding and acoustic screens; Demolition of manhole using a pneumatic breaker; and Deep excavation work. Installation of a new Thames Water connection to our Stanhope Street site. We may need to temporarily close

Location 4a Georgiana Street / Camden Street / Pratt / Delancey / Parkway	March to November 2022	UK Power Networks utility connection works on behalf of SCS. Works include: Traffic management; Site set-up and hoarding; and Excavation and installation.
Gerogiana / Camden / Oak Square / Eversholt / Euston Road	Trial holes May to June 2022 Main works September 2022 to March 2023 June to December 2022	UK Power Networks utility connection works on behalf of MDjv. Works include: Traffic management; Site set-up and hoarding; and Excavation and installation. UK Power Networks utility connection works on behalf of MDjv. Works include: Traffic management;

Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Old Maria Fidelis School site	February to May 2022	Utility works and concrete pouring for the Construction Skills Centre and welfare site at the former Maria Fidelis School site.
	Spring 2022	New water connection by Thames Water to the Construction Skills Centre and welfare site compound at the former Maria Fidelis School site. Partial footway closure in pedestrianised passage between Hampstead Road and North Gower Street.

Location 2 HS2 Euston Station site	April to October 2022	Enabling works package for main HS2 station. These works including removing a significant amount of concrete such as slabs, ramps, piles and pile caps. Once these have been removed, we will then install a pile mat and undertake pile testing.
Location 3 One Euston Square and Grant Thornton buildings	April to October 2022	 Completion of the demolition of One Euston Square and Grant Thornton buildings' ground floor and basement levels, and associated works. Alteration of current hoarding, including closure of the west colonnade at Euston Station; New hoarding erected within the bus station; Ramp to be constructed to provide a step free fire escape route from the offices and shops on the west colonnade; and Demolition works using combination of pneumatic breaker and claw on columns, walls, ground floor and basement slab.
Location 4 Euston Square Eastern Gardens	Ongoing throughout 2022	Construction of an interim taxi set-down, pick-up and rank facility to serve Euston Station while the HS2 station is constructed: • Enabling works, including hoarding; • Installation of temporary utilities; • Tree protection and site preparation; and • Traffic and pedestrian management
Location 5 Former National Temperance Hospital (Hampstead Road)	Ongoing to late Autumn 2022	 Enabling works at the former National Temperance Hospital site and the interface with Hampstead Road. Works will include: Extension of the hoarding and traffic management along Hampstead Road to enable work in the basement; Pile extraction and installation of piling mat; Removal of redundant petrol station tanks; and UK Power Networks utilities diversion.

Location 6 Euston Square Western Gardens	Ongoing until late 2024	Relocate the existing Transport for London traction sub-station and vent shaft to enable the HS2 main station construction. Works in the coming months include: • Excavation works; • Construction of turning head for vehicles at the end of Stephenson Way; and • Start of substructure construction.
Location 7 Cobourg Street (7a), Euston Road – North and South (7b) & Gordon Street (7c)	March to mid- June 2022	Ground investigation surveys to help us understand more about the current ground conditions in the local area. This work will involve drilling holes into the ground using machinery. Surveys will be done in the following locations: Cobourg Street: late March to mid-April; Euston Road north: late March to early May; Euston Road south: late April (two nights); and Gordon Street: early May to mid-June.
Location 8b North Gower St, between Stephenson Way and Euston Road	February to May 2022	 Demolition and rebuild of an Openreach manhole: Closure of left turn into North Gower Street and traffic diversion in place; Site set-up including hoarding and acoustic screens; Demolition of manhole using pneumatic breaker; and Deep excavation work.
	November 2021 to March 2022	Excavation of a section of the road to connect new UK Power Network electricity cables, then reinstatement of the road.
Location 8c Drummond Street	Spring 2022 (date tbc)	Installation of a new Thames Water connection to our site. This work will require a road closure at the corner of Cobourg Street and Starcross Street, off-set from the pub to reduce disruption.
Location 8d	March to May 2022	Sewer connection surveys (manhole inspections).

Location 9 Various utility works (north of the station) Coburg St / Starcross St / North Gower St / Euston St / Hampstead Road	April to summer 2022	Utilities secondary diversions (comms, power, water and gas), including local traffic management, will be phased during the following times: Starcross Street: mid-April to late May; Hampstead Road: mid-May to mid-July; North Gower Street: late May to late June; Cobourg / Drummond Street junction: summer 2022 (tbc); and Euston Street: summer 2022 (tbc).
	May to July 2022	Full road closure of Starcross Street to allow us to install sewer lining protection to the existing Starcross Street sewer.
	Mid-April to mid- June 2022	Digging of a trial hole to find out the condition and location of an existing gas main.
Location 10 Drummond Street	Mid-May to August 2022	Construction of a sewer connection from the Network Rail station basement to the existing Eversholt Street sewer.
Location 11 Eversholt Street	Ongoing until late 2022	Replacement and relocation of existing hoardings and installation of new graphics west of the station, including Melton Street, Cobourg Street (south), Regnart Buildings, Stephenson Way and Hampstead Road.

Involving

- We will involve you in opportunities to benefit and learn as we build HS2 including jobs, skills, education, employment and funding.
- We will ask you about the design of specific parts of the railway.

Responding

- Our dedicated HS2 Helpdesk is available 24 hours a day, every day of the year, to help with any questions or concerns you have about HS2 or our work.
- If things go wrong, we have a complaints process and a dedicated complaints team.
- An independent Construction Commissioner monitors how we manage and deal with complaints.

Consulting

- We will hold formal consultations with you while we seek permission to build Phase 2b of HS2.
- We now have permission to build Phase One and Phase 2a. This means we will only
 formally consult on this part of HS2 when we need permission to do things that fall
 outside the terms of the legislation agreed by Parliament.

We are committed to keeping you informed about work on HS2. This includes ensuring you know what to expect and when to expect it, as well as how we can help.
