High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. As we increase face to face engagement, in addition to virtual engagement, we will ensure all events and meetings adhere to the guidelines. Ground investigations on Parkway

In April we will carry out ground investigations on Parkway, at the junction of Gloucester Avenue and Delancey Street, to survey the structure of the bridge. We will use these surveys to inform tunnel design and works to protect the bridge before we begin tunnelling.

These ground investigation surveys involve drilling into the ground to take samples from around the railway tunnels beneath the road. For safety, we can only drill near the railway tunnels when they are not in use.

We will breakout the tarmac and prepare our working area for the surveys from 7 to 14 April. We will then carry out the surveys during extended working hours from 15 to 18 April, during the Easter rail closure. We will carry out a range of surveys involving large drill rigs, and survey trucks some of this equipment will be noisy. Once the surveys are complete, we will reinstate the road and remove our traffic management.

Our working hours will be

- 8am to 6pm from 7 to 14 April (weekdays only)
- 7.30am to 10.30pm from 15 to 18 April during the Easter rail closure
- 10.30pm 17 April to 12.30am 18 April to reinstate the road and move traffic management

Duration of works

Works on Parkway: 7 to 18 April

24/7 works during Easter rail closure: 15 to 19 April

24/7 works during May bank holiday: 30 April to 2 May

What to expect

Traffic management on Parkway, Delancey Street and Gloucester Avenue

Surveys during day and night shift on Parkway junction

Piling, surveys and monitoring onsite during extended hours

Increased noise from piling and survey equipment, during extended hours

These works will be noisy, particularly as we breakout the road and remove obstructions to prepare for the surveys and during drilling. We apologise for the disruption. We will use acoustic blankets where possible to limit noise.

Traffic Management – lane closures on Delancey Street, Parkway and Gloucester Avenue

We will require lane closures on Delancey Street, Parkway and Gloucester Avenue and lane narrowing on Albany Street from 7 to 18 April. The left-hand turn from Delancey Street onto Parkway will be suspended and traffic will be diverted via Gloucester Avenue, Regent's Park Road, St Mark's Square and Prince Albert Road.

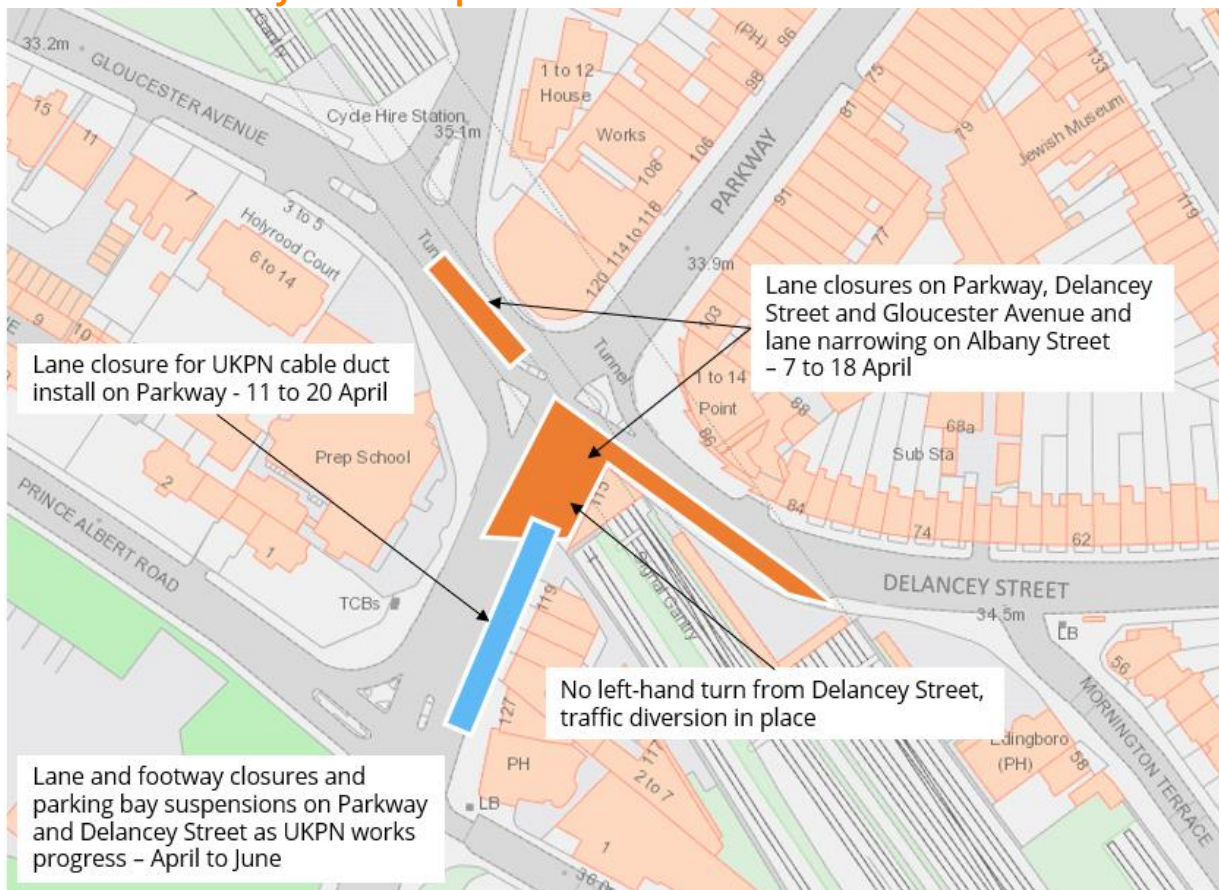
We will temporarily close the cycle lane at the junction of Gloucester Avenue and Parkway junction to make way for works. An alternative cycle route will be signposted.

We will also close sections of the western footpath on the corner of Parkway and Delancey Street to make way for works. A pedestrian route will be maintained past working areas.

We will return in late spring to carry out ground investigation trial holes in Parkway area, also requiring traffic management. We are still planning these works and will provide an update closer to the time.

Please be aware UKPN will be installing cable ducts in this area from April to June.

24/7 works during Easter rail closure – 15 to 19 April

Our worksite is located immediately next to live railway tracks. For safety, works closest to the tracks can only be carried out when the tracks are not in use.

We will carry out **works 24/7, day and night, during the upcoming Easter rail closure from 15 to 19 April**. Works will include

- Ground investigation surveys on Parkway above the railway tunnels (as described above) during day and night shifts
- Piling beside the tracks in Euston Throat worksite, from 4am to 10pm
- Surveys and monitoring of structures within the railway cutting (from Park Street tunnels to Hampstead Road bridge) during day and night shift

There will be periods of increased noise between 8am and 10.30pm from surveys on Parkway and piling works in the Euston Throat as we dig (auger), pour concrete and vacuum excavate the top of the piles.

24/7 works during May bank holiday – 30 April to 2 May

We will also carry out **24/7 works during the May bank holiday weekend**, from 30 April to 2 May. Our works will include

- Surveys and monitoring of structures within the railway cutting during day and night shift
- Piling beside the tracks in Euston Throat worksite from 4am to 10pm

We apologise for the disruption. We understand it can be difficult living next to a major construction site and we continue to plan and design our works to reduce impacts as much as possible.
