

UPDATE - Notice of night shift works – Berkswell Station

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

UPDATE

We previously notified you that BBV will be carrying out preparatory works, on the West Coast Main Line near to Berkswell Station on Saturday nights from 27 February to 10 April.

Following feedback from the community we will be suspending the works this weekend (26 and 27 March) in order to make changes to address the concerns that have been raised.

We plan to resume work the following weekend (2 April) where we will be using a pile driver to install the remaining steel pile foundations for the new overhead power line poles before the existing equipment can be dismantled and the new power line installed.

The West Coast Main Line will be closed between 10.00pm and 8.00am on each Saturday night. The workforce will access the railway through the rear of Berkswell Station car park and Truggist Lane compound. We will keep you updated through www.hs2insolihull.co.uk.

- Low level noise from the pile driver.

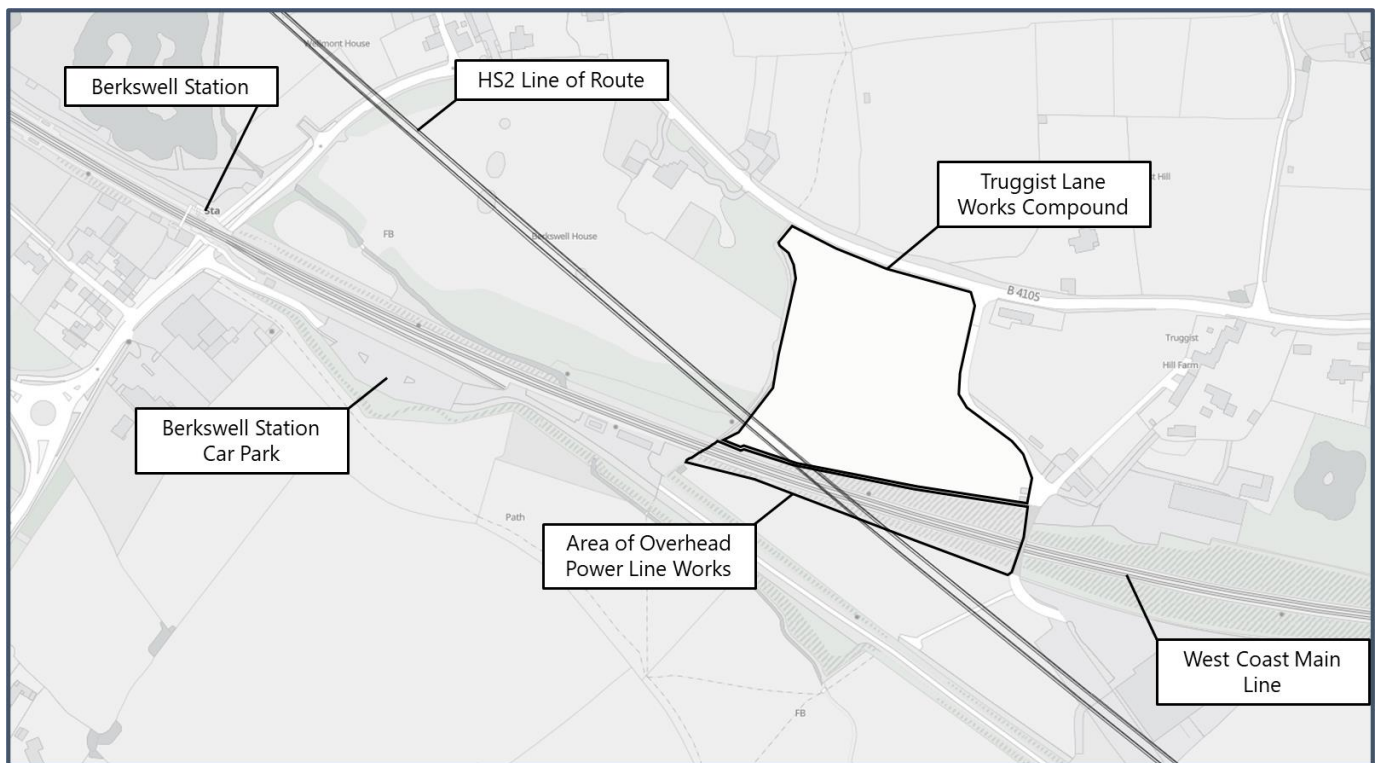
