High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. As we increase face to face engagement, in addition to virtual engagement, we will ensure all events and meetings adhere to the guidelines. Extended working hours at Atlas Road site

Works are continuing on site to construct the Atlas Road Logistic Tunnel ramp and launch box in preparation for the launch of the tunnel boring machine later in the year.

We are now reaching the stage where we will need to commence with a series of large concrete pours and curing to complete the ramp leading to the launch box. The concrete pours need to take place continuously.

From 30 March to 9 June 2022, we may need to extend our working hours from 8am to 8pm Monday to Friday. We will not be working extended hours every day, but may need to work extended hours on the dates the concrete pours are planned, as follows:

- 30 March 2022
- 20 April 2022
- 6 May 2022
- 9 May 2022
- 20 May 2022
- 7 June 2022
- 9 June 2022

Please note these dates may change by +/- 1 day throughout the period stated above.

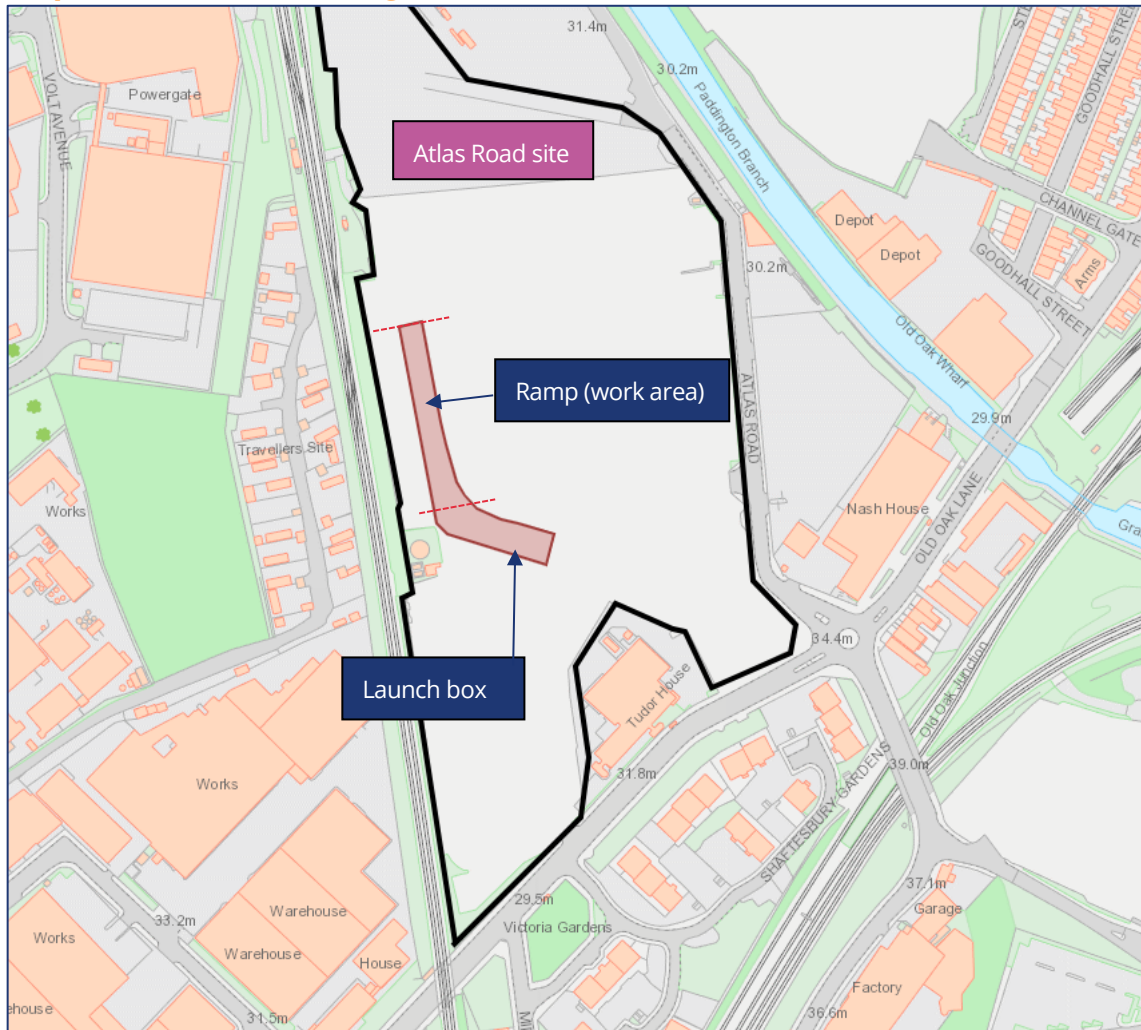
