High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. What Are We Doing?

To support the construction of HS2 between the North Portal of the Chiltern Tunnels and Brackley, we will be undertaking overnight topographical surveys along Lower Road, near Station Road and Risborough Road.

In order to carry out these surveys safely and effectively, we will need to put in place overnight road closures with signed diversions. This is required because our staff will be working directly on the carriageway.

When will these works take place?

A section of Lower Road will be fully closed overnight, between 8.00pm and 6.00am, Tuesday 3 May to Saturday 7 May 2022, with local diversion in place.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services.

We will work to open the roads to reduce disruption as soon as possible. Should there be delays to our works, these dates may be subject to change.

Duration of works

Our surveys will commence Tuesday 3 May and are expected to be complete by Saturday 7 May 2022.

Overnight Hours:

Monday to Saturday

7.00pm - 6.00am

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

A section of Lower Road will be fully closed overnight for topographical surveys.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

What are topographical surveys?

A topographical survey is an exercise undertaken by land surveyors using highly specialised survey equipment. Topographical surveys provide detailed maps of land, identifying both natural and man-made features within a specified area.

These surveys will record the location and sizes of features, such as:

- Hedges
- Grid covers
- Kerbs
- Road layouts
- Road markings
- Grass verges

- Building footprints
- Walls
- Walkways
- Underground utilities
- Water courses and extents of ponds and lakes
- Slopes, natural banks and depressions in the land

Topographical surveys will help us to finalise the design of the new railway and road alignments and where possible allow us to reinstate features after construction. Our team of surveyors will be using a digital measure or camera also known as a 'total' station, shown in the picture below, to record what is present.
