



Notice of ground investigation works – Fosse Way, Offchurch

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be completing

We're carrying out ground investigation (GI) work to help us better understand the ground conditions along the HS2 route. This will help to inform the design of the railway. To do this, we will use techniques including the drilling of boreholes and trial pits.

From **Wednesday 20 April 2022** to **Tuesday 3 May 2022**, we need to carry out GI works near Fosse Farm. The purpose of this work is to help with the design of the Offchurch Cycle Bridge over Fosse Way.

To carry out this work, we will use some heavy goods vehicles as well as light goods vehicles, such as tractors and telehandlers

Our GI sub-contractor will be setting up a boring rig to take soil samples of the ground. The rig will be set up for the duration of the work and will operate **Monday to Friday** only between **8am** and **6pm**.

Location

This work will be taking place on the Fosse Way between the junction of Long Itchington Road and Hunningham Hill, near Bericote Park, CV33 9BQ.

How we will reduce disruption

We will keep construction traffic to a minimum wherever possible. To reduce impact on your journeys we will avoid travelling at peak times during the day. We will also keep our sites secure at all times.

From Wednesday 20 April 2022 to Tuesday 3 May 2022.

Our working hours will be 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday only.

Our workforce may be on site one hour before and one hour after, to set up and secure our equipment.

Soil boring rig, site vehicle, 360 excavator and welfare facilities.

Low levels of noise from the work we are completing.
