High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work will we be doing

Works are due to start on the construction of a temporary site access off Station Road roundabout, Balsall Common which will serve as a delivery point for materials to construct HS2. Key to the construction programme is to complete the new Carol Green Bridge crossing of the West Coast Main Line which can be accessed from this point for the south abutment works. On completion of the bridge there will be a continuous site haul road along the line of route from the Aston Martin Roundabout through to Burton Green.

Initial works will involve vegetation clearance (please see map) and protection to the existing utilities around the new access.

When these works will take place

Works are scheduled to start from Tuesday 19 **April 2022** and our working hours will be Monday to Friday from **8.00am** until **5.00pm**. Our workforce maybe on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment. These works are subject to weather conditions.

To carry out this work safely the road will be managed by our BBV traffic management team where "Stop and Go" boards will be used when necessary to assist in the first phase of works.

- Minor delays to local journeys.


