High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high-speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Road closures on the A452 Kenilworth Road

Please find below updated dates for traffic management to support the final phases of construction of the roundabout on the A452 Kenilworth Road, Berkswell, close to Park Lane.

What to expect (Updated dates)

28 May – 1 June - overnight road closures on the southbound carriageway 8pm to 6am. Park Lane access remains closed from the A452. Please follow diversion.

Extended night working hours: **Saturday 28 May** to **Tuesday 31 May** inclusive **8pm** until **6am**

Ongoing until further notice: Single Lane closures on both carriageways 24 hours a day seven days a week with daytime working hours Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm. Traffic management, including all signage, will be erected as and when required subject to consent, site and weather conditions. Please keep an eye out for signage on the road as dates are also subject to change.

Further information

Local diversions will be clearly signposted. Access for residents and businesses within the A452 closure will be maintained by approaching the traffic marshall at the relevant closure point. **For live up-to-date traffic information and diversion routes please go to one.network.** For more information about works in your area please register with **www.hs2insolihull.co.uk**

 hours: Saturday 28 May until
 Tuesday 31 May inclusive
 8pm to 6am

Our contractors may be onsite one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure the site.

What to expect


Some noise from on-site machinery during working hours.
