Notice of temporary road closure on Lavender Hall Lane and Truggist Lane, Berkswell

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Temporary Traffic Management

There will be temporary traffic management on the dates outlined below on Lavender Hall Lane and Truggist Lane near Berkswell. This will allow safe access to our work sites to carry out vegetation clearance to prepare for the future construction of the railway. The temporary traffic management will be a full road closure on Lavender Hall Lane using traffic cones spanned across the road and verges to prevent access. The traffic management will be in place between 09:30 am and 3:30 pm as below:

- **Phase 1:** Lavender Hall Lane Tuesday 19 April to Friday 22 April 2022
- **Phase 2:** Truggist Lane Monday 25 April to Wednesday 27 April 2022.

There will be a full road closure on Truggist Lane from the Baulk Lane junction to the railway bridge. Traffic cones will span the road and a gateman will be present.

Our teams will be on site one hour before and one hour after the works to set up and secure the site at the end of each day.

Please note that Cadent Gas may be working on Church Lane near the junction into Lavender Hall Lane.

What we will do

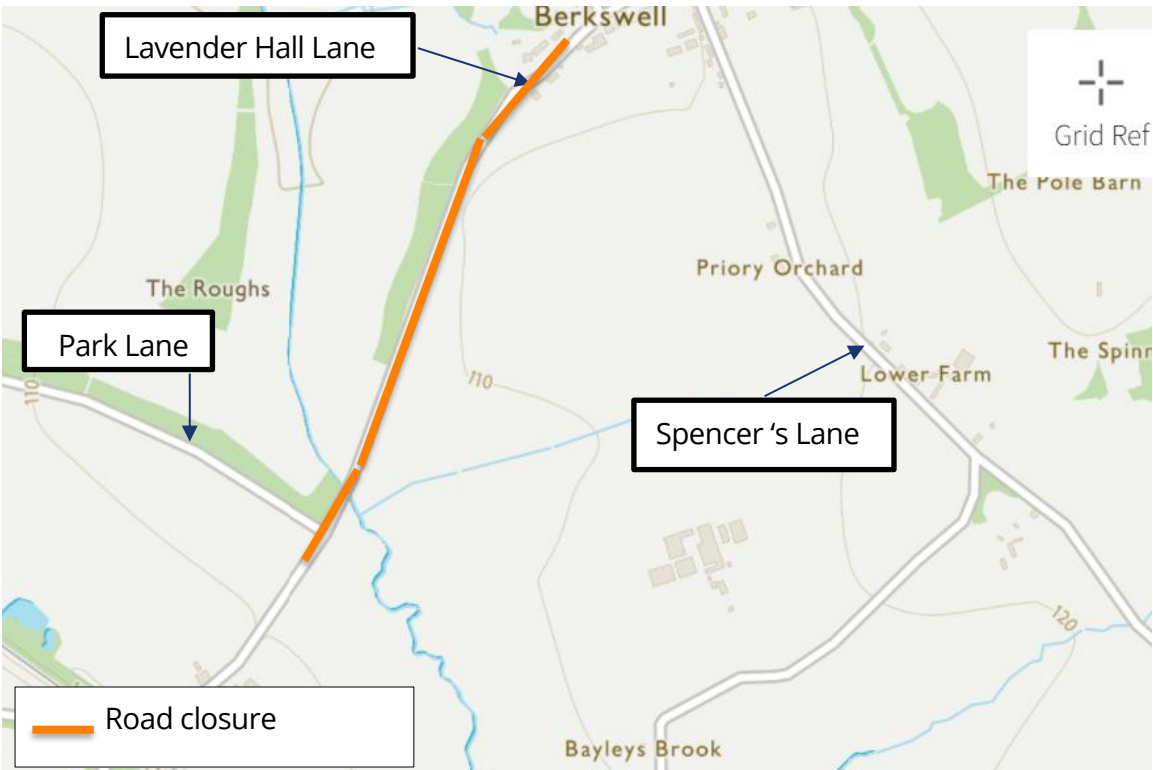

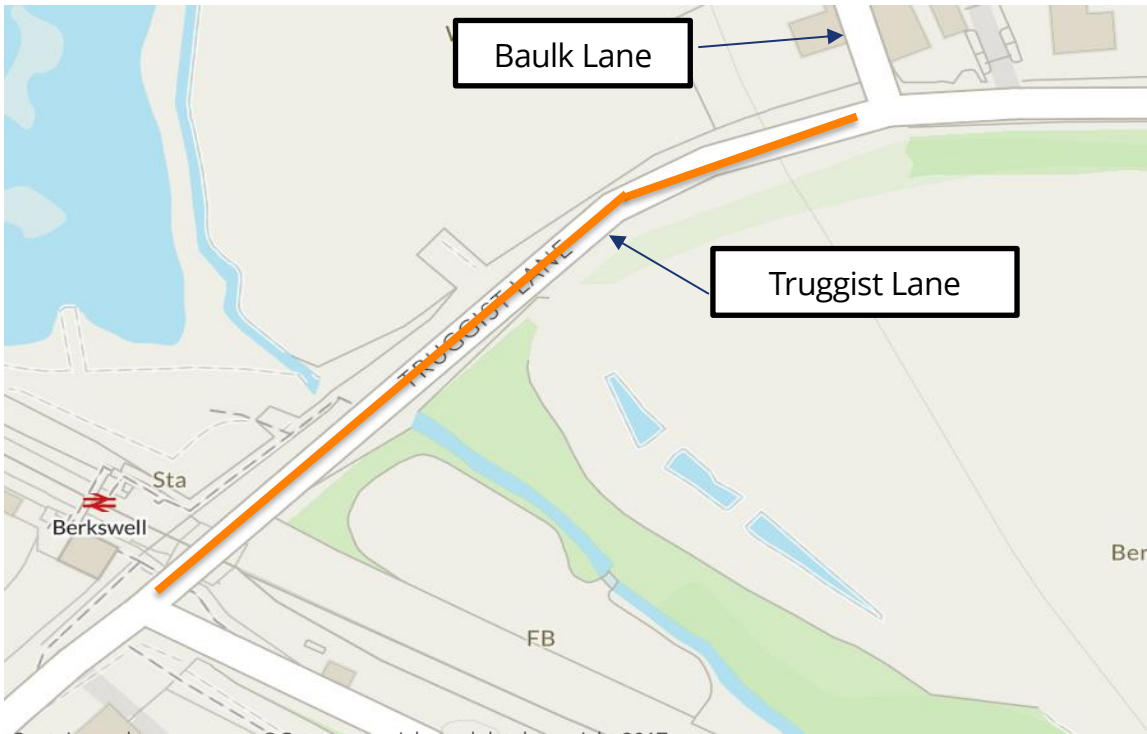
