High Speed Two (HS2) is the high-speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work will we be doing

Owing to recent storm damage, we will be working with BT to install new underground ducts, replacing the current overhead line cables. In order to carry out the installation safely, we will be installing a full closure on Stoneleigh Road near Stareton. A fully signed diversion will be in place during this closure (please see map overleaf).

Access to all properties will be maintained throughout this closure.

When these works will take place

The Stoneleigh Road will be closed 24 hours a day from 16 May 2022 to 18 May 2022. Our working hours will be 8am to 6pm. Our workforce may be on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.

- Our works are scheduled from 16 May 2022 until 18 May 2022.
- A full closure will be in place 24 hours a day while the works are being carried out.
- Our working hours will be 8am to 6pm.
- Our workforce may be on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.

What to expect

- Some disruption to travel times.
- A fully signed diversion will be in place.
- Access to all properties will be maintained during this closure.
- Some noise from onsite machinery during working hours.

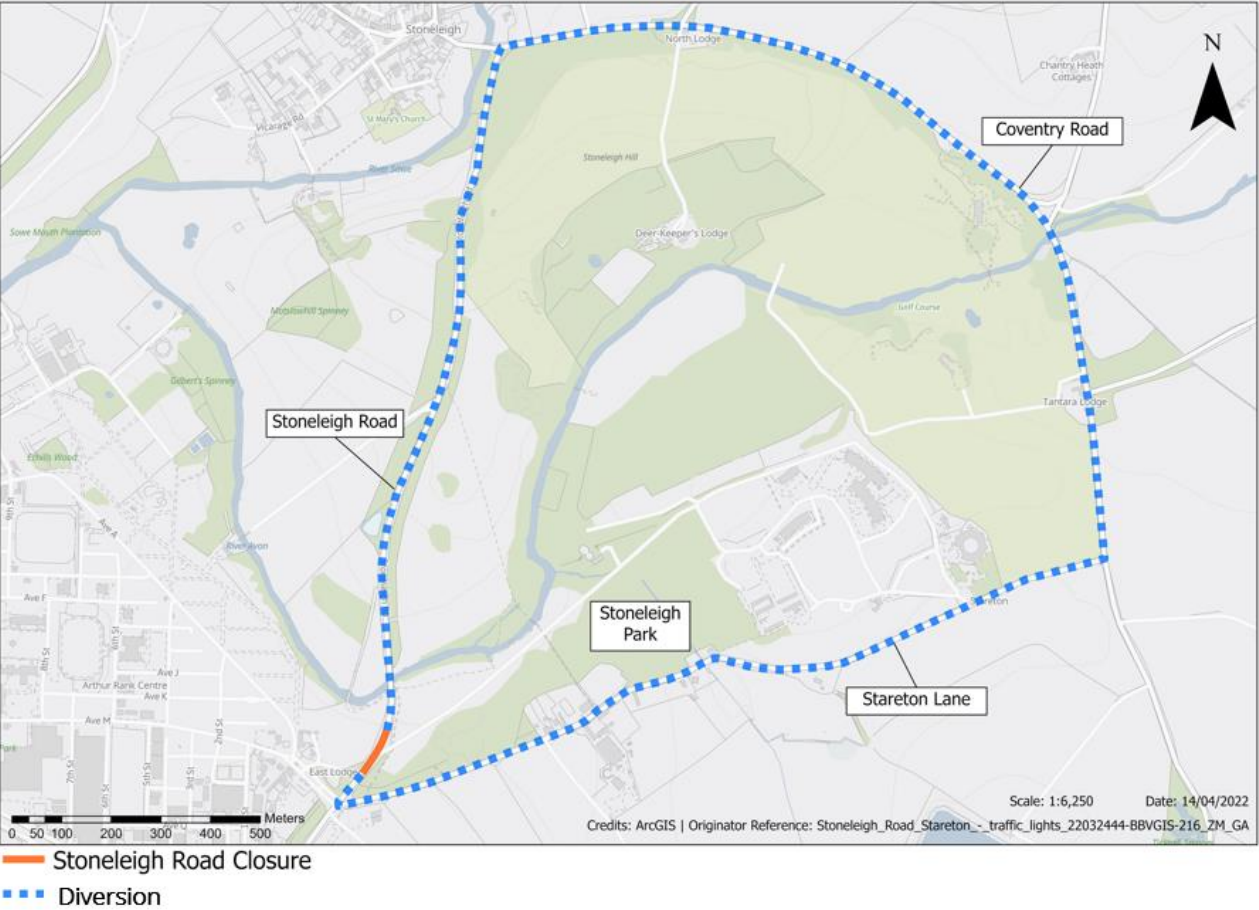
