High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work will we be doing

BBV will be carrying out vegetation clearance along the verge behind the layby on the north bound carriageway just north of the Truckstop on the A452 Kenilworth Road. To carry out these works safely we will be closing the layby during the day on the 9 May and the 10 May 2022.
