IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT CARPENTER COURT CAR PARK RESTRICTIONS

UK Power Networks run and operate the electricity network delivering power in London, the Southeast and East of England.

On behalf of HS2, we are in process of installing electricity cable ducting on Pratt Street and Camden Street. This work will not have any impact on your electricity supply.

Our works will commence from Thursday 21st July in Pratt Street and anticipate to continue until Friday 26th August in Camden Street. Most of our working hours will be from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday. There may be times when weekend working is required however we will minimise these shifts where possible. You may see some of our construction vehicles delivering and working around the small site as well as hearing sporadic excavation sounds. The area will be safely fenced off at all times and access will be available to Pratt Street and Camden Street with a two way traffic light management set up. Construction works will inevitably generate sound but we will be working within permitted hours and noise restrictions set out by Camden Council.

To allow us to deliver the works we are required to work on weekends of Friday 5th August to Sunday 7th August. Our proposed working times will be from 8am to 5pm Saturday and 9am to 2pm on Sunday. The area of works will be on Pratt Street around St Martin's Garden.

During this weekend mentioned above, access to the entrance of St Martin's Garden and the car park for Carpenter Court will be restricted. The entrance to St Martin's Garden will be closed for any vehicle access on Saturday 6th and Sunday 7th. The entrance to Carpenter Court's car park will be closed during Friday 5th August from 10am to 2pm, Saturday 6th August from 11am to 2pm and Sunday 7th August from 9am to 12pm. Please arrange for your vehicle movements to be around these times. Thank you very much for your cooperation.
