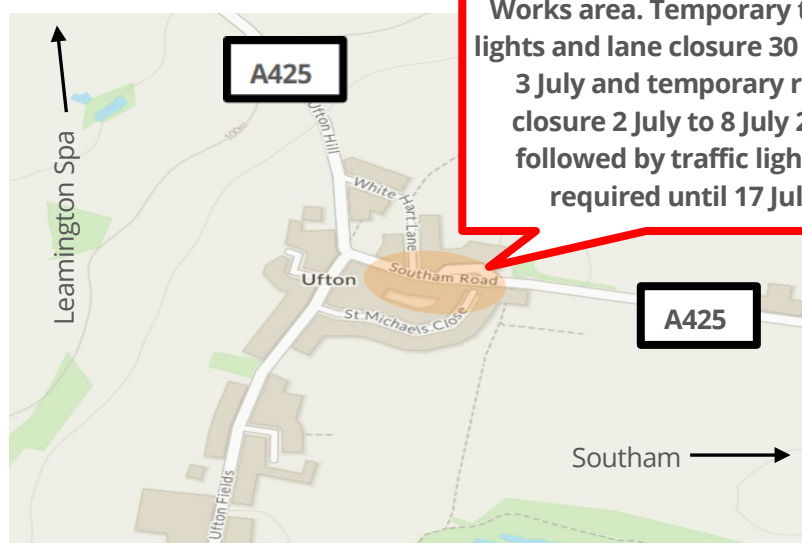
High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Updated dates for Ufton pedestrian crossing works

LM will be constructing a new pedestrian crossing in the village of Ufton. In order to carry out these works safely, we will be installing temporary traffic lights and a single lane closure along the A425 Southam Road in the village from Thursday 30 May until Monday 3 July (excluding Jubilee bank holiday weekend). This will be followed by a **temporary road closure** from **Saturday 2 July until Friday 8 July** and lastly temporary lights from 11 July the 17 July, if required to complete works.

Access for local residents and businesses will be maintained and diversions will be clearly signposted during closure periods. Our work is subject to change – for live traffic information go-to **one.network** and please check **on-the-road signs**. Please note: BBV will also be closing the A425 for tree pruning under off-peak hours (9:30am – 3:30pm) on 27 June (near Ufton roundabout), 28 and 29 June near Harbury Crossroads and 30 June (A425 Leamington Road, near Dallas Burston Polo Club).
