High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

As we reintroduce face to face engagement, which is in addition to the ongoing virtual engagement, we will continue to follow government guidance on reducing the spread of Covid-19. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. ### **Surveys planned on Bideford Avenue**

From 20 to 22 June 2022 between 9pm and 6am, we will be carrying out overnight surveys on Bideford Avenue between the Wadsworth Road and Tavistock Avenue.

The surveys will help us to understand the condition of the drainage system in the area and how best to protect them during the construction of the railway. We will investigate the manhole using a 3D camera scanner to capture internal dimensions and the condition of the sewer system.

Your utility services will not be affected during these works.

### How might this affect you

Overnight on 20 June, we will have a full road closure in place on Bideford Avenue, under the Transport for London rail bridge near Tavistock Avenue.

Overnight on 21 June, we will have a full road closure in place on Bideford Avenue between Wadsworth Road and Transport for London rail bridge.

Access to businesses and homes within the road closure will be available at all times.

Monitor our working methods to minimise disruption to you




### Road closures on Bideford Avenue from 20 to 22 June 2022

To help us maintain traffic flow on the road network, we have agreed the following diversion route:

Vehicles travelling south on Bideford Avenue will be diverted west onto Bilton Road, south on Horsenden Lane South and then east on Teignmouth Gardens,

Vehicles travelling north on Bideford Avenue will be diverted west onto Teignmouth Gardens, north on Horsenden Lane South and then east on Bilton Road.

Access to businesses and homes within the road closure will be available at all times.
