



Notice of survey works, Tolldish Lane

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are writing to make you aware of the next stage of work that will be undertaken by British Pipeline Agency (BPA) that is related to HS2.

What we are doing

Due to the future planned HS2 railway development works, will investigate the requirement for a diversion of an existing high-pressure pipeline that will cross HS2 associated features.

During August 2022, BPA will carry out minor excavation works to locate buried services near to Tolldish Lane. We will use excavators to carry out this work and to do this safely, we will need to close approximately 50 metres of the southbound lane on the A51, as shown by the area shaded blue on the map below, for no more than five days. During the closure, we will put temporary traffic lights in place.

How will this affect you

The work will take place in Great Haywood, mostly within fields, although some works will be alongside the A51. BPA will carry out the work from Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm.

As the works are largely within rural fields, there should be limited disruption to local businesses, although there will be an increase in construction traffic. These traffic movements will be kept within the required limits.

Covid-19

BPA is delivering these works as part of the HS2 construction programme. The Government's current COVID-19 strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. Please be assured that those sites that are working are doing so because they can operate within Public Health England and construction industry guidelines.

The works will begin on 1 August 2022 and are expected to last for up to two weeks.

Lane closure on the A51 for no more than five days, and a very slight increase in construction traffic.
