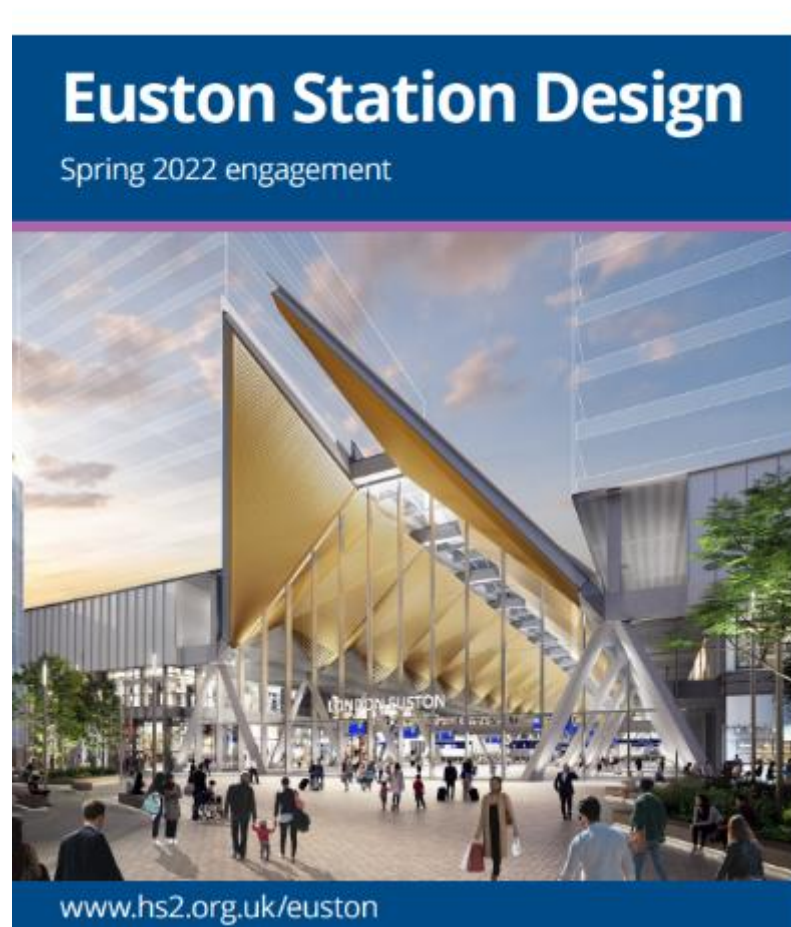

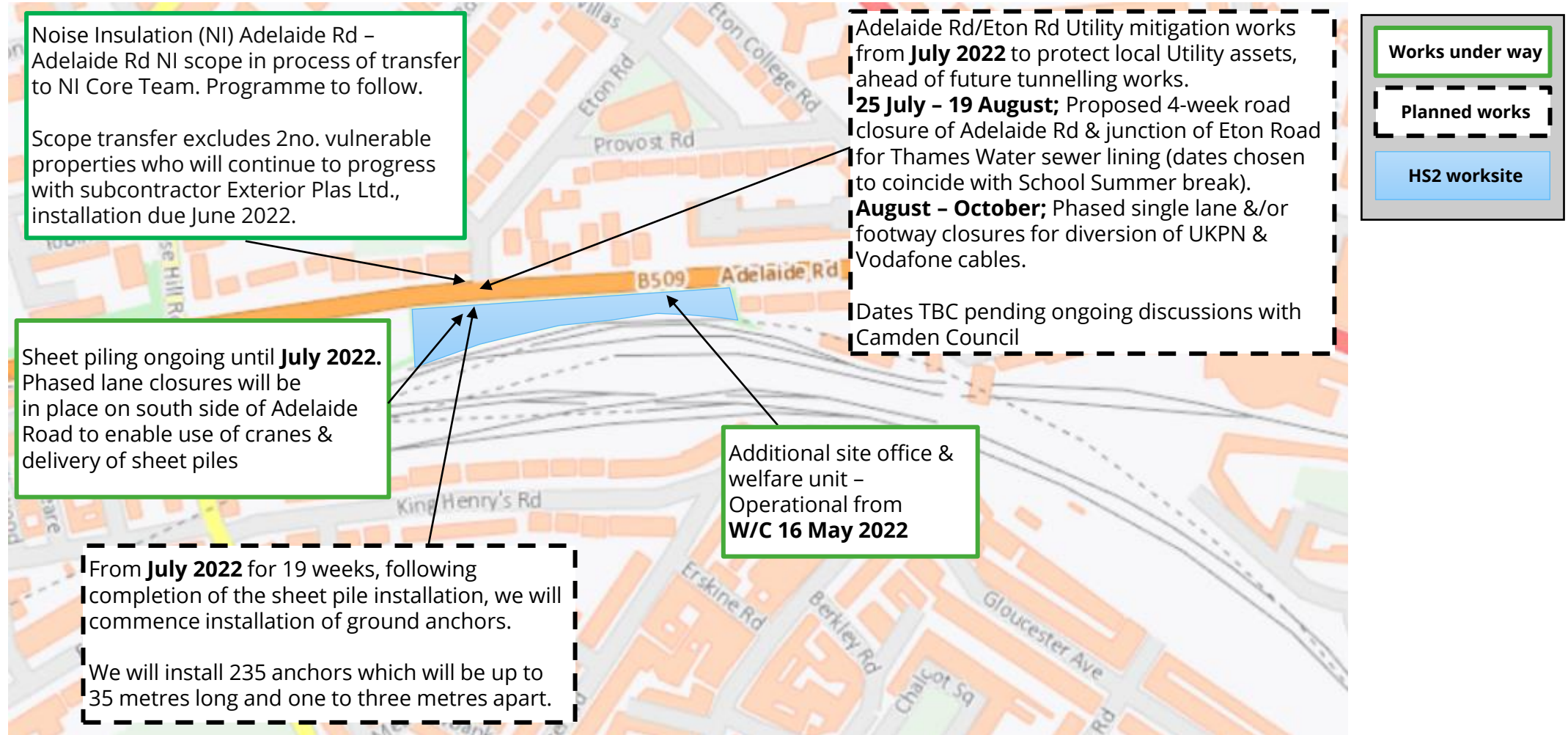

# Proposed utility works on Adelaide Road and Eton Road

In summer 2022, we will have a road closure in place on the junction of Eton Road with Adelaide Road. We are currently planning to carry these works out from 25 July to 19 August 2022.

We need to carry out utility works to protect the main sewer in Adelaide Road which will involve installation of a sewer liner to strengthen the existing sewer pipe. Once the works are complete, the sewer pipe will be protected while we build the HS2 tunnels in the London Borough of Camden.

We will install a temporary access point on Eton Road and will construct a permeant manhole on Adelaide Road. We will do this by digging into the ground to create a trench which will be at the depth of the main sewer pipe underneath Adelaide Road. Once complete, we will carry out the installation of a liner inside the sewer.

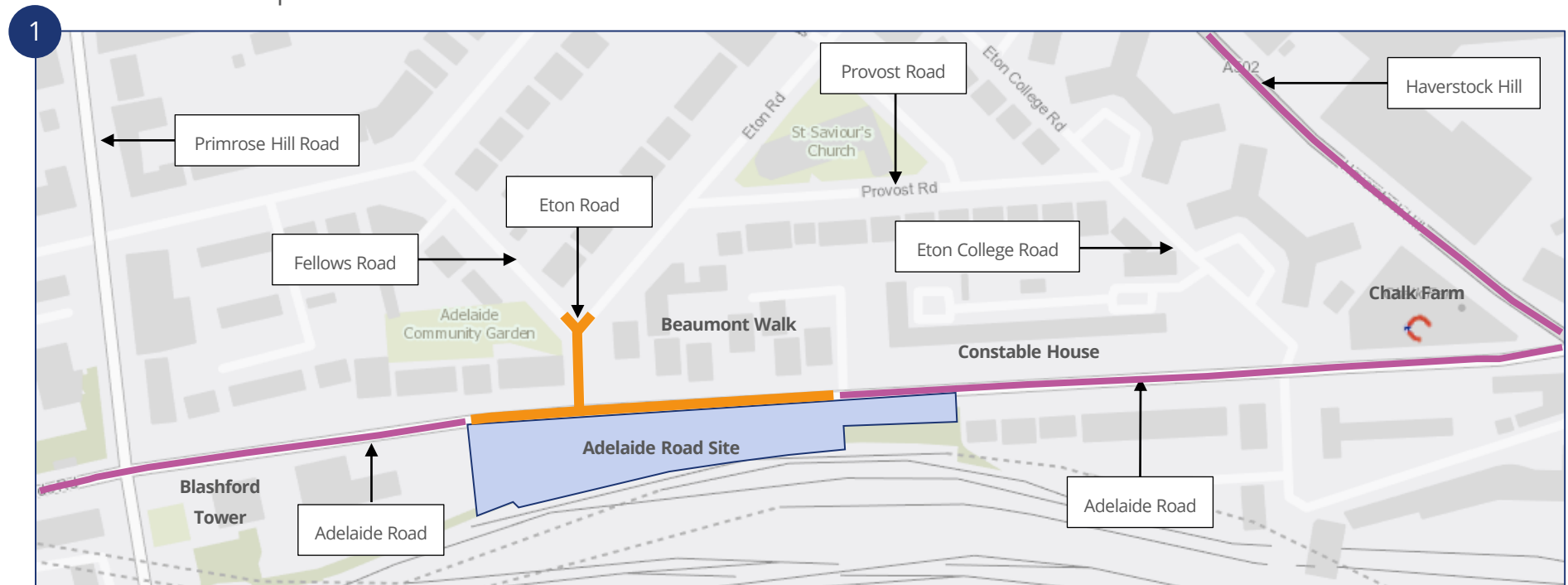

# Proposed Adelaide Road and Eton Road diversion route

## How can I travel through the area?

### Travelling by bus

Eton Road (Stop R), Chalk Farm (Stop CB) and Chalk Farm (Stop CA) will be closed for the duration of our works. The nearest bus stops for bus routes 31, N28 and N31 are Finchley Road South Hampstead (Stop K) and The Roundhouse (Stop CF).

### Travelling by car

To help us maintain traffic flow on the road network, we have agreed a diversion route with Camden Council and Transport for London.

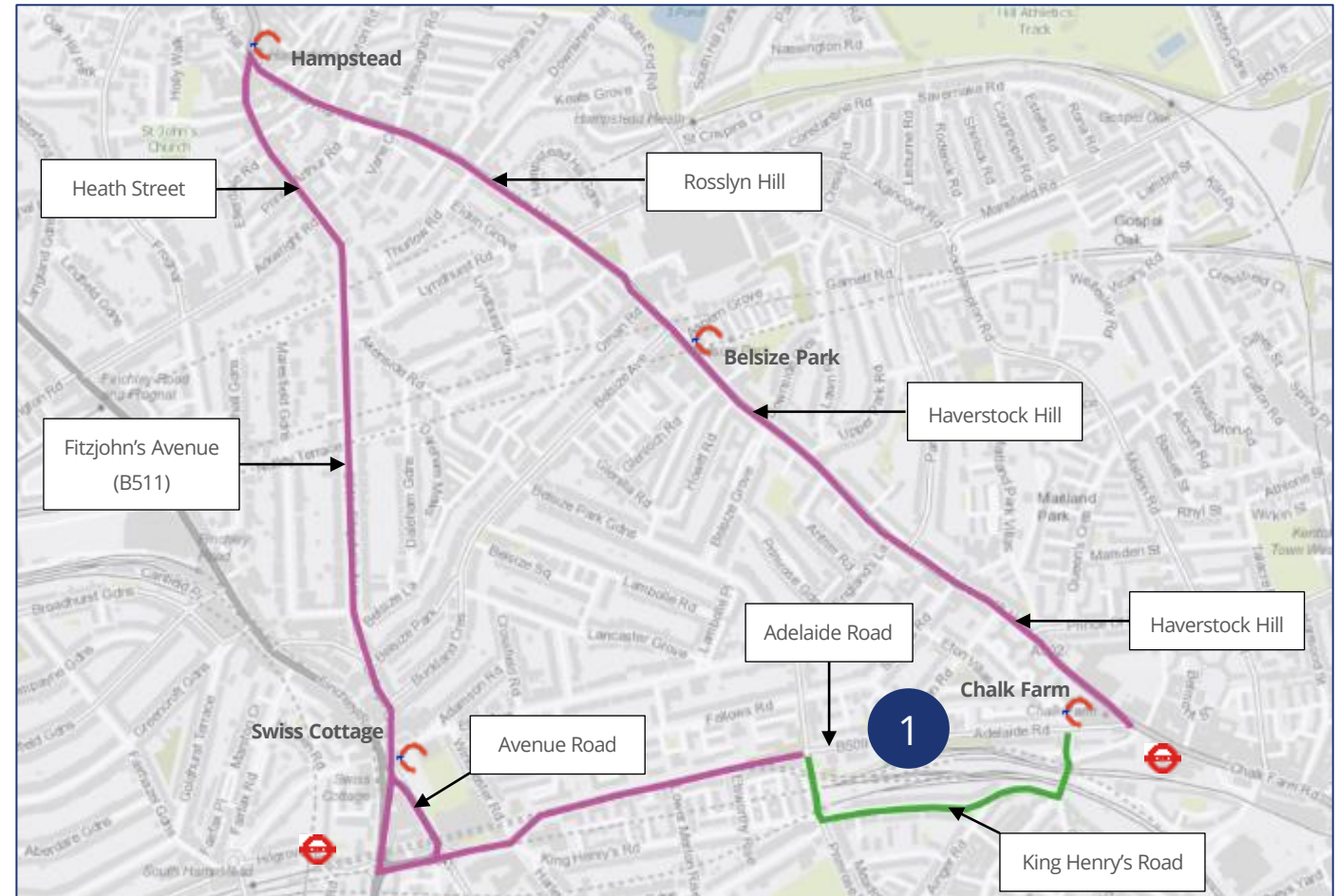

### Travelling by bicycle

Cyclists will be diverted towards King Henry's Road. We have agreed this diversion route with Camden Council.

### Travelling by foot

Pedestrians will be diverted up Eton Road and will be able to walk around the road closure. A clearly signed diversion route will be available.

# Proposed utility works on Eton Road

Early Summer 2022, we will have a road closure in place on Eton Road.

Once the sewer lining works are complete on the junction Eton Road with Adelaide Road, a road closure will remain in place on Eton Road to reinstate the temporary access point.

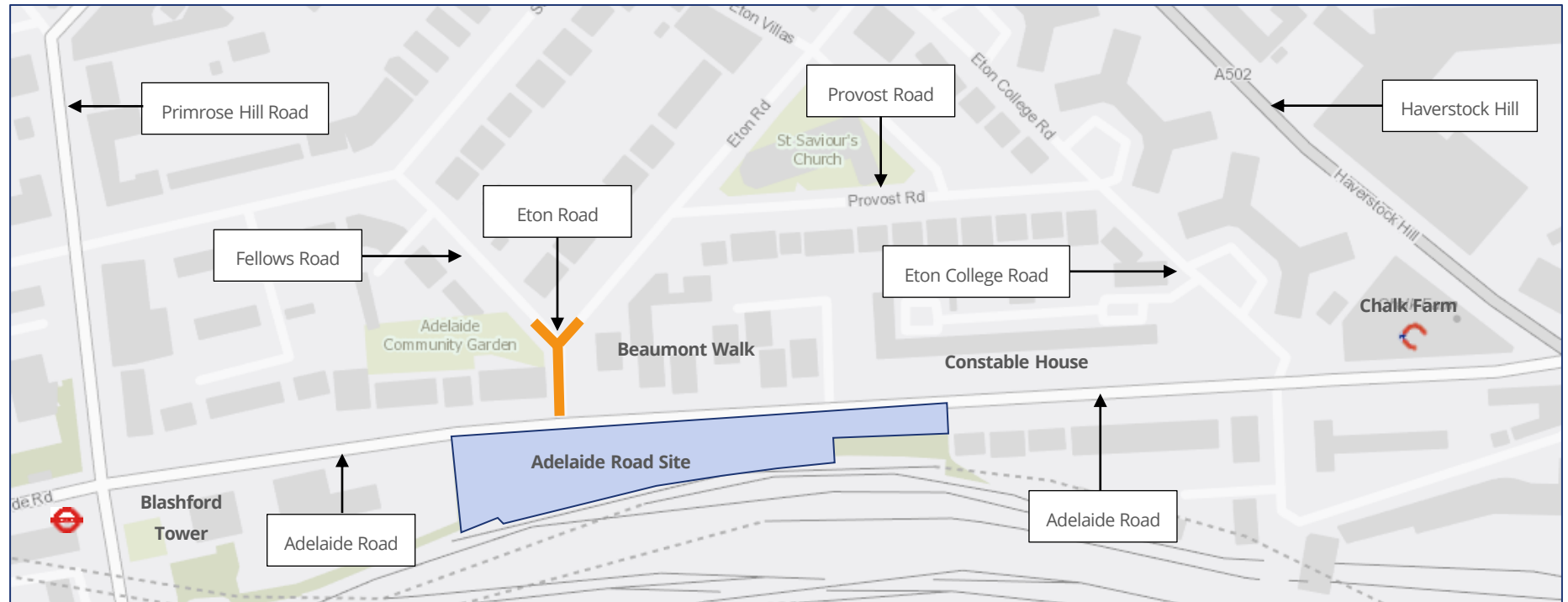

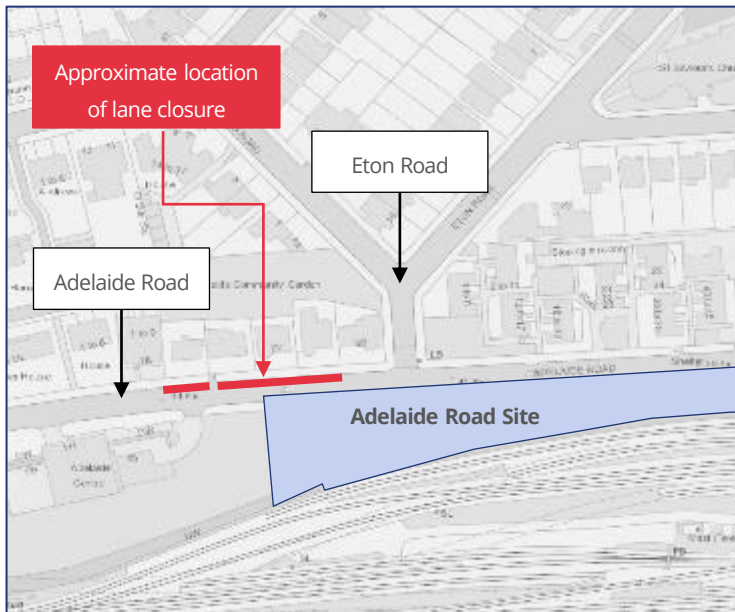

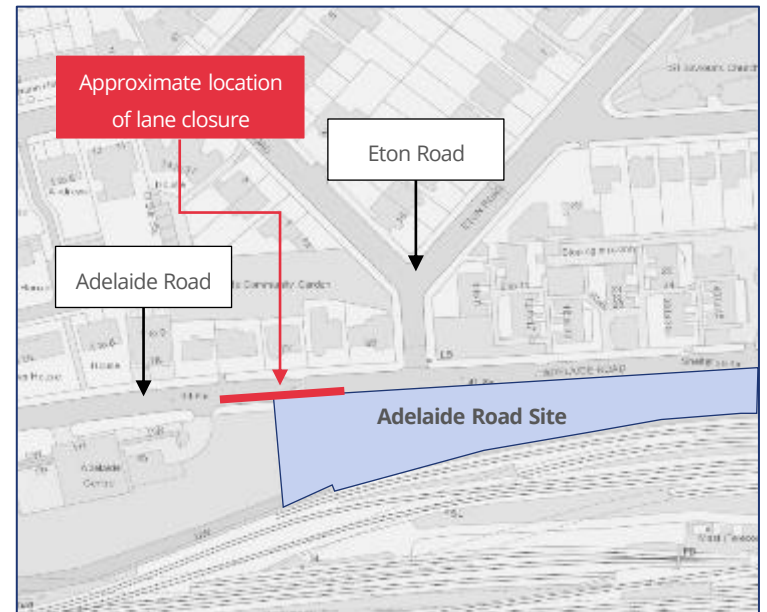

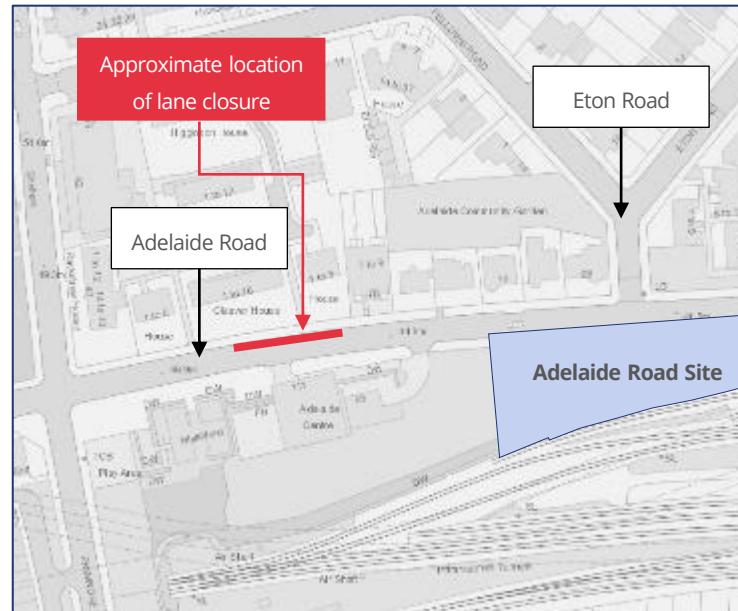

# Adelaide Road Vent Shaft

## Engagement and Community Investment update

### February – May 2022

- **24 February** Adelaide Road Community update event held, to provide an overview of ongoing and upcoming works at the Adelaide Road Vent Shaft site and surrounds.. Key upcoming works were presented, included the new site office & welfare installation in March and the future ground anchor installation
- **16 March, 20 April, 18 April** virtual 1:1 sessions held for residents local to Adelaide Road. Residents are able to book a 20-minute slot, sessions are held months on Wednesday afternoon-evenings. Attendance: 0 attendees in March, 2 attendees April, 2 attendees May
- **21 March** Adelaide Road walkaround - SCS Community & Stakeholder Engagement colleagues met with newly appointed LB Camden HS2 Support Worker.
- **23 March** Camden Tree Panel met to discuss vegetation pruning on boundary of Adelaide Road Vent Shaft site
- Two face-to-face resident 1:1 meetings were held **14 & 21 April**, attended by SCS Community Engagement Manager and an Engineer from the Adelaide Road vent shaft site. The 1:1's were scheduled following enquiries to the HS2 Helpdesk regarding future ground anchor installation
- **17 May** Castlehaven Community Centre 'Edible Garden' transformation; 12 SCS JV staff volunteered to give the garden in London Borough of Camden a makeover, with repurposed planter boxes constructed and shingle and other surplus material used for irrigation. An Ash tree from the Adelaide Road site which fell during Storm Franklin was also donated. In addition to being a green space for the community, the garden is used to grow food which is distributed by the Centre's weekly food bank and used in cookery workshops
- Adelaide Road Community update event held **20 May 3 – 7pm** at St. Saviour's Church, Eton Villas; to provide an update on current and upcoming works. There were 18 attendees from the local community; key topics of interest were Ground Anchor installation works, Noise Insulation and the Summer Utility works.

- Euston Approaches noise insulation team will also cover Adelaide Road noise insulation using the same approach



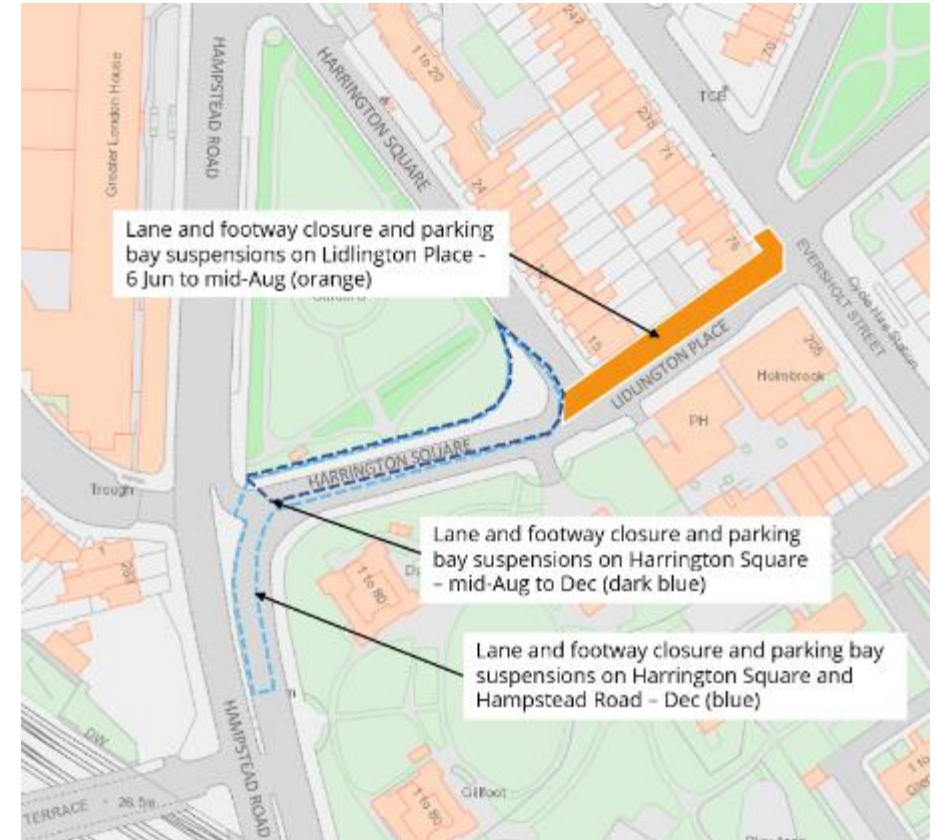
# Utility diversion from Lidlington Place to Varndell Street | 6 June to Spring 2023

## Works on Lidlington Place

New cable route installed from Lidlington Place to Varndell Street via Granby Terrace, to replace the existing route next to Hampstead Road

- Property access maintained



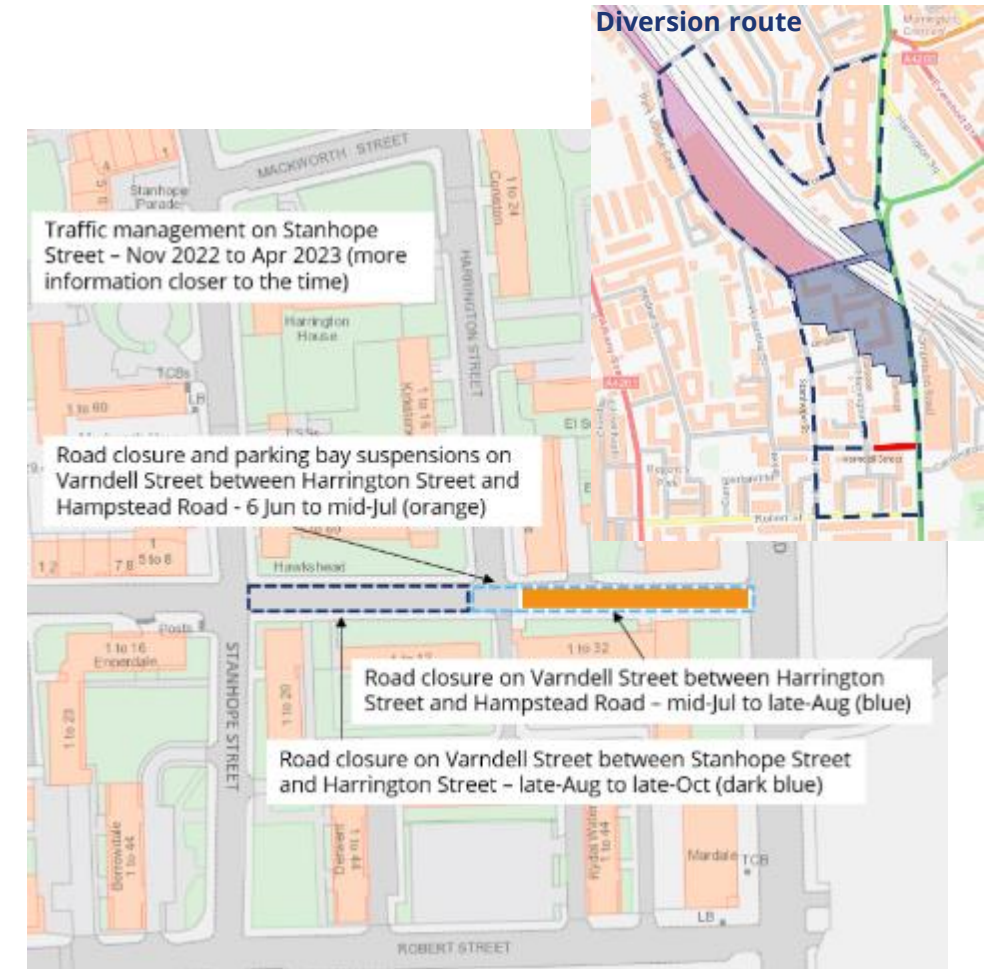
# Utility diversion from Lidlington Place to Varndell Street | 6 June to Spring 2023

## Works on Varndell Street

New cable route installed from Lidlington Place to Varndell Street via Granby Terrace, to replace the existing route next to Hampstead Road

### Traffic impact:

- Road closure and parking bay suspensions on Varndell Street between Harrington Street and Hampstead Road
- Traffic diversion
- Footways maintained
- Property access maintained





# Park Village East utility mitigation works | 4 July to 24 August

## Works:

- Install sewer lining at northern end of Park Village East
  - Includes CCTV surveys, works to adjust existing manholes and install sewer lining (via existing manholes)
- CCTV surveys of sewer (via existing manholes)

## Traffic impact:

- Overnight road closure as well as lane narrowing and parking bay suspensions for sewer lining
- Lane narrowing and parking bay suspensions for CCTV surveys



# Parkway utility mitigation works | summer 2022

## August 2022 to spring 2023

- Works carried out one at a time, in phases
- Continue to look at options to reduce the impact of these works as we work through the planning process
- Notice providing an overview of the works, followed by updates as the works progress
- Coordinate with those closest to the works to reduce impact



# Parkway utility mitigations | impacts & mitigations
