High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. If you have any questions about this, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. What are we doing?

As we move into the main construction works around Quainton, there are some upcoming sections of work that will require some local road closures and temporary traffic management over the next few months. They will consist of the following works:

- Utility relocation and connections on Station Road and Fiddlers Field, also known as Snakes Lane;
- Site access construction on Station Road; and
- There will also be times where multi-phase traffic lights will be used on a section of Fiddlers Field and the junction on Station Road.

We have split the works into 5 different working phases. During each phase, we will need to fully close the identified section of road because we will be working in open trenches, directly within the carriageway.

All of the works are south of the Buckinghamshire Railway Centre, so residents and road user access will be through Quainton Village as well as via our diversion routes detailed in this notice.

When will these works take place?

- **Phase 1 - Station Road North** – Thursday 14 July to Friday 22 July – completed.
- **Phase 2 - Station Road South** – Monday 25 July to Thursday 12 August (24/7)
- **Phase 3 - Fiddlers Field** - Saturday 13 August and Sunday 14 August (24/7)
- **Phase 4 – Fiddlers Field/Lee Road** – Monday 15 August and Tuesday 16 August (24/7)
- **Phase 5 - Station Road North** - Wednesday 17 August to Friday 30 September (24/7)

Some of these future dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

Duration of works

Works will commence on -

Station Road from
Thursday 14 July 2022

Fiddlers Field from
Saturday 13 August 2022

24-hour full road closures.

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

24-7 full road closures and some additional traffic.

There will be times multi-phase traffic lights will be in use on Fiddlers Field and the junction on Station Road.

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods for the diversion of utilities.

Noise from plant and equipment used for the works.

Some weekend closures.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

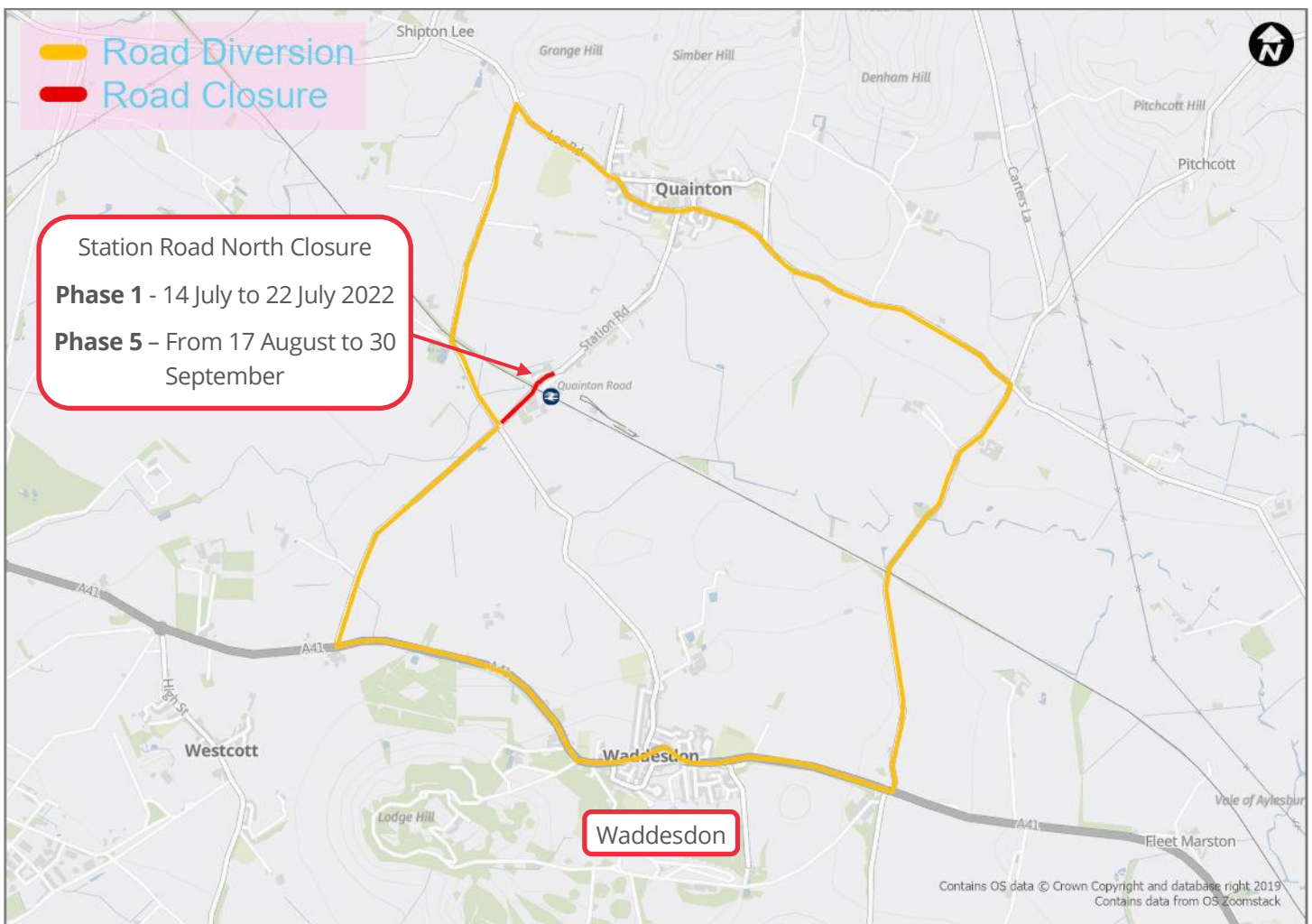

Phase 1 & Phase 5 - Where will the works take place?

The map below, shows the section of Station Road that will be fully closed 24-hours a day during Phase 1 and Phase 5. During Phase 1 in July, we relocated utilities along a section of Station Road. During Phase 5 in August, we will be constructing an entrance from Station Road to our Station Road Compound.

Access will be maintained for residents and local businesses.

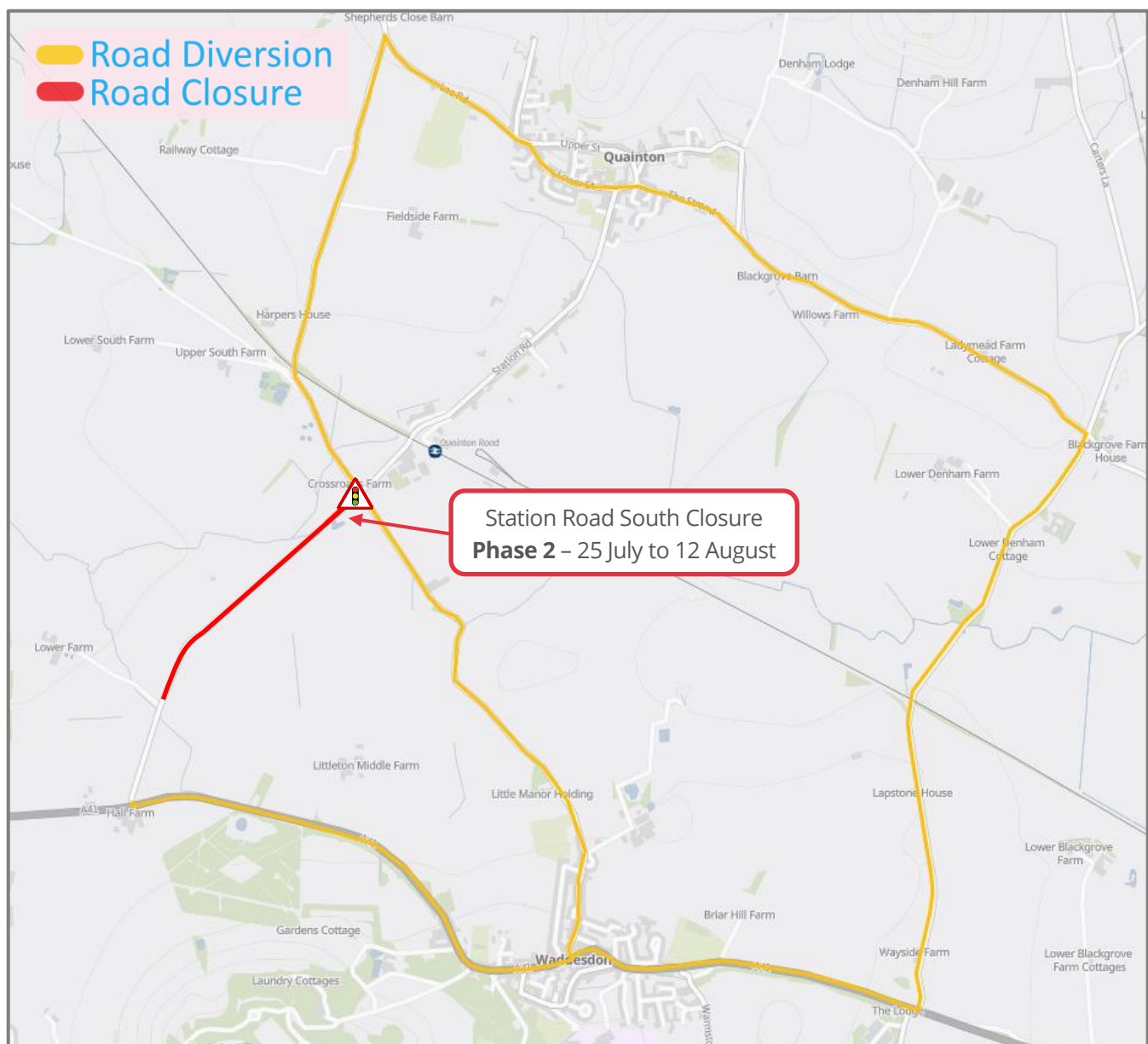

Phase 2 - Where will the works take place?

The map below, shows the section of Station Road that will be closed 24-hours a day during Phase 2 and the local diversion route. Due to the nature of our works and for reasons of safety, there will also be temporary multi-phase traffic lights at the crossroads.
