Works on Park Village East and Mornington Street bridge

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Sewer lining on Park Village East north – 17 to 24 October

We are carrying out works to strengthen and protect the utilities beneath Park Village East before we begin tunnelling and major excavations in our Camden Cutting worksite.

From **17 to 24 October**, we will install a lining within the sewer at the northern end of Park Village East via existing manholes within the road. We will work 24/7, day and night to install the lining.

Road closure and parking bay suspensions on Park Village East north

We will suspend parking bays and narrow the lane in front of properties 2 to 4, 16 and 22 to 28 Park Village East to safely access the manholes.

We will close the road at the northern end of Park Village East each **night from 18 to 21 October, between 7pm and 7am**, while we work. We will also close the road for an hour during the day on 18 and 19 October. **These works will not be noisy.** Resident access to Park Village East north will be maintained via Parkway.

Footway closures and parking bay suspensions on Park Village East south

From **17 to 21 October**, we will suspend parking bays and close sections of the rail-side footway on Park Village East south to survey the sewer via manholes. We will carry out the surveys one at a time, releasing each parking bay as we complete the relevant survey.


Road closure on Mornington Street bridge for survey – November

We will close Mornington Street bridge for four weeks from **7 November to 4 December**, while we dig a trench across the width of the road to survey the structure. This survey will be used to inform mitigation works to the bridge, due to start in summer 2023, ahead of tunnelling.

We will **maintain access for cyclists and pedestrians, but vehicles will be diverted.**

Traffic on Park Village East will be one-way, while the bridge is closed, with vehicles travelling from north to south. North-bound vehicles will be diverted via Stanhope Street, Mackworth Street, Harrington Street, Varndell Street, Hampstead Road, Mornington Crescent and Clarkson Row.

Once we finish the survey, we will fill in the trench and reopen the road as quickly as possible.

Footway closures and parking bay suspensions on Park Village East for survey preparations and reinstatement works – 24 October to 6 November and 5 to 16 December

Before we can dig the trench, we need to clear our working area at the junction of Park Village East and Mornington Street bridge. **From 24 October to 6 November**, we will remove a section of the planter and hoarding on Park Village East, on the corner of Mornington Street bridge. **From 5 to 16 December**, once we've finished the survey, we will carry out works to reinstate the area.

We will require footway closures and parking suspensions on the corner of Mornington Street Bridge and Park Village East to carry out these works. Vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians will be able to access Mornington Street bridge during the preparatory and reinstatement works (see map on page 2).

We will use hand tools and a small excavator to remove the planter and dig the trench across the road. We will take steps to limit noise such as hanging acoustic blankets around our working area, but you may notice periods of increased noise from these works. We are sorry for the disruption.

Please note, we will close Mornington Street bridge again from summer 2023 for about five years to protect the bridge during tunnelling. We will maintain access for cyclists and pedestrians where safe to do so, but vehicles will be diverted.

Utility works on Hampstead Road and Robert Street - October to March 2023

Starting in October, Mace Dragados JV, will install a new watermain at the junction of Hampstead Road and Robert Street. The work will be carried out in phases involving different traffic arrangements. For more information about Mace Dragados works please see 'Notice of works on Hampstead Road' (September 2022).

Access in and out of Regent's Park estate via Hampstead Road – October to March 2023

Access to Hampstead Road

Vehicle access from Robert Street to Hampstead Road will be closed from October to March 2023. Vehicles trying to access Hampstead Road will be diverted via Stanhope and Drummond Street. From mid-October access will also be available via Mackworth Street, Harrington Street and Varndell Street onto Hampstead Road.

Access from Hampstead Road

Vehicle access from Hampstead Road into Regent's Park Estate will be maintained via Robert Street, and Drummond Street from October to late-November. From late-November to March 2023, access via Robert Street will be closed but vehicles will still be able to access the estate via Drummond Street and Varndell Street.
