## **Notice of spray applied** water proofing system at **Old Oak Common**

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As we reintroduce face to face engagement, which is in addition to the ongoing virtual engagement, we will continue to follow government guidance on reducing the spread of Covid-19. #### Spray applied waterproofing system

On the dates 11, 12, 18 and 19 August, we will be carrying out some waterproofing works. This activity involves spraying a waterproofing product onto the reinforced concrete structure to protect from water damage, such as leaks, and ensuring longevity of the station.

This activity will take place within the confines of the HS2 Station Box in the Stamford Brook Sewer and the ground floor slab towards the East of the site. Please see the map on Page 2 for the location of these works.

On the 11 and 12 August, this activity will take place within the confines of the HS2 Station Box Stamford Brook Sewer and on the 18 and 19 August, it will take place at the East Box site. These works will take place during the normal working hours of 8am - 6pm.

The waterproofing product is not toxic; however, it has a distinctive smell during application. This smell typically disappears once cured approx. 2 hours after application.

#### **Duration of works**

On the dates 11, 12, 18 and 19 August, we will be carrying out the activity of spraying a waterproofing system.

This will take place during normal working hours of 8am - 6pm.

What to expect

A distinctive smell for several hours during the day.

What we will do

We will use best practicable means to minimise any disruption by applying the waterproofing system within the enclosed area of the Stamford brook Sewer and the furthest section of site at the **East Box, minimising** any smell where possible.
