

Notice of footpath closure and diversion, SM90, Ladbroke

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. What are we doing?

This summer, we have begun excavating and moving earth with large plant and machinery. For reasons of safety, a section of Public Right of Way (PRoW) SM90, also known as the Harry Green Way, will be diverted near Ladbroke Hill Lane.

The footpath will be diverted for a short distance along a new access track. This track will have shared access between footpath users, as well as farm and Severn Trent Water access. This diversion reconnects with the existing footpath near Ladbroke Hill, allowing walkers to continue their journey along this long distance path.

The safety of users is paramount and further alterations or closures may be required as the earthworks continue.

When will these works take place?

Footpath SM90 (The Harry Green Way) will be diverted for a short section near Ladbroke Hill Lane, from Monday 22 August 2022 for a period of approximately three years.

Duration of works

PRoW SM90, also known as the Harry Green Way, will be diverted from Monday 22 August 2022.

What to expect

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

Footpath closure and diversion of SM90 for approximately 3 years.

Noise from plant and equipment used for the earthworks.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

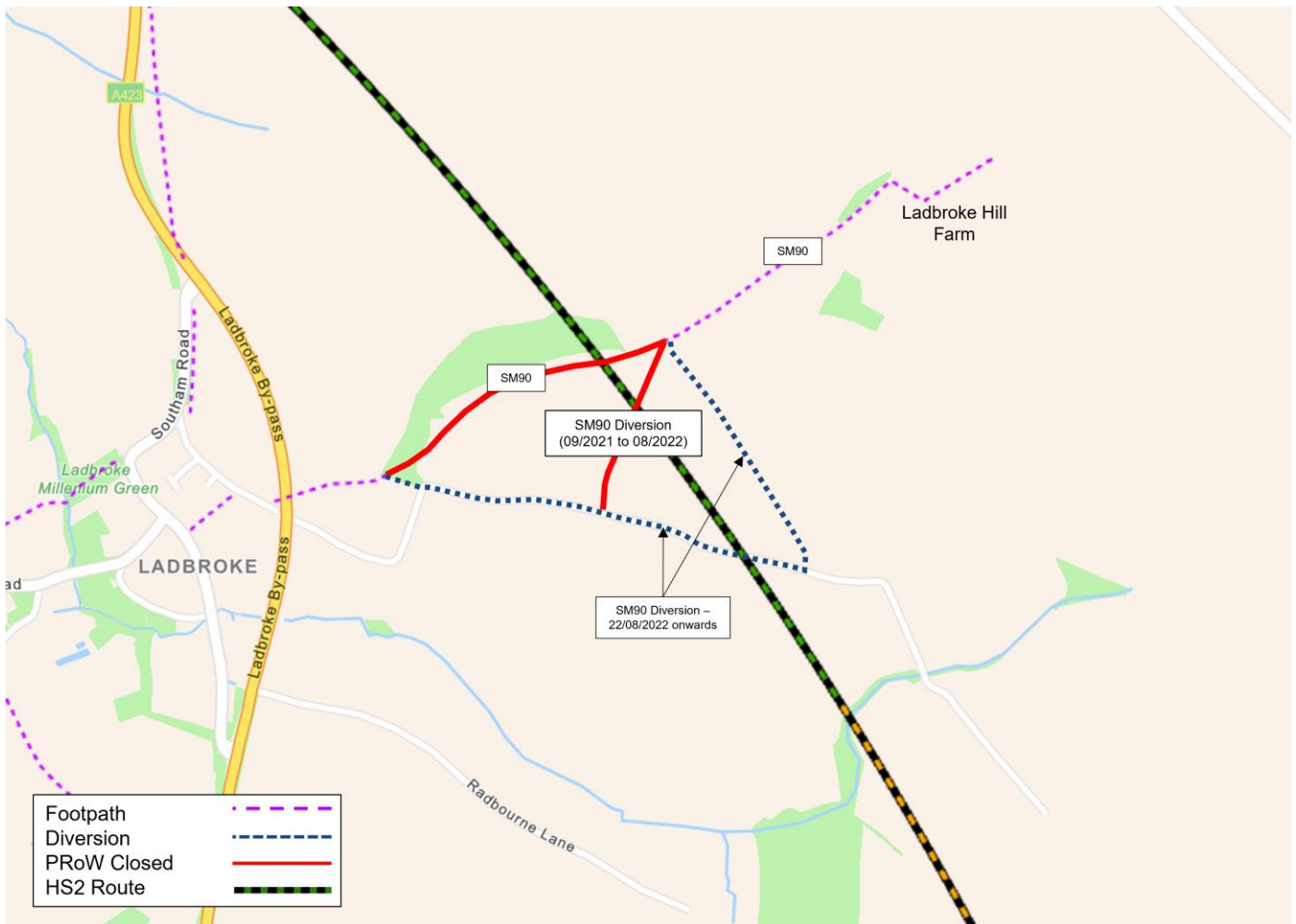
