



Upcoming road closure Crackley Lane, Kenilworth

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

In order to complete the design for the Crackley Lane Overbridge we need to dig trial holes to locate the existing drainage system. As part of these works, we will also complete the resurfacing of Crackley Lane adjacent to the existing plant crossing. To carry out this work safely we will be closing sections of Crackley Lane. The work will be carried out in three phases. Each phase will involve work on a different section of Crackley Lane and will have its own diversion route.

When these works will take place

Phase one: A full road closure between Blind Lane and Cryfield Grange Road from **8am on Tuesday 30 August 2022** and **6pm on Thursday 1 September 2022**.

Phase two: Between Cryfield Grange Road and Brockendon Road on **Friday 2 September 2022**. The closure will be between **8am** and **6pm**.

Phase three: Between Blind Lane and Coventry Road on **Monday 5 September 2022**. The closure will be between **8am** and **6pm**.

A fully signed diversion will be in place for each Phase (please see map overleaf) and access will be maintained to all properties during these works.

Our workforce may be on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.

From **8am** on **Tuesday 30 August** to **6pm** on **Thursday 1 September 2022**.

Friday 2 September 2022 from **8am** to **6pm**.

Monday 5 September 2022 from **8am** to **6pm**.

Our workforce may be on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.
