### **Installation of electricity cable ducts – Oakley Square**

UK Power Networks run and operate the electricity network delivering power in London, the Southeast and East of England. On behalf of HS2, we are undertaking works to enable installing new electricity cables in the area. In partnership with our contractor, Modus Utilities, we will be installing electricity cable ducts. This work should not have any impact on your electricity supply.

We will be doing three phases of works on Oakley Square. Our first section of works are planned to commence on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> August and complete on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August. Our second and third section of works are planned to commence on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September and complete on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> September.

We will be working Monday to Friday between 8am and 6pm. UK Power Networks has consulted with the local authorities and other relevant parties to ensure that the public experience as little disruption as possible whilst our work takes place.

The works will consist of excavation of a cable trench in sections as the works progress along the route. Each section will be fenced off and acoustic barriers will be installed to limit noise. We will have traffic management and provide clear signage for pedestrians and vehicles around the work sites. We will require some parking suspensions for the duration of these works.

We apologise for any inconvenience that may be caused by our works and will make every effort to keep the impact to your area to a minimum.
