Anti-skid road works on Gordon Street – update on date changes

Dear Customer,

We run the electricity network delivering power to your area. The work, in partnership with our contractor Modus Utilities, is part of a project to supply a new electricity connection, for the HS2 Project. Our work should not have any impact on your electricity supply.

We previously got in touch regarding night time works to complete our anti-skid road works. We have amended for these works to be during the day time. We will be commencing these works from Thursday 18th August to Monday 22nd August. Our working hours will be between 8am and 6pm, Monday to Friday.

The works are for anti-skid dressing. We will be closing one lane on Gordon Street across the junction mouth of the Gower Place junction, with no access of Euston Road from Gordon Street. Diversion routes will be place whilst we carry out these works safely. We will require parking suspensions for the duration of these works.
