## A452 Kenilworth Road - roundabout works

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high-speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

### Lane and road closures on the A452 Kenilworth Road

Please find below dates for traffic management to support the final phases of construction of the roundabout on the A452 Kenilworth Road, Berkswell, close to Park Lane.

### What to expect

**22 Aug to 26 Aug** – lane 1 closures northbound and southbound 9.30am to 3.30pm (contingency dates 5 Sept to 7 Sept)

**30 Aug to 2 Sept** – lane 2 closures northbound and southbound 9.30am to 3.30pm (contingency dates 8 Sept to 9 Sept)

**30 Aug pm to 1 Sept am** – overnight full northbound road closure 8pm to 6am with diversion. **Park Lane access will be under escort from the A452.**

**2 Sept pm to 4 Sept am** – overnight full southbound road closure 8pm to 6am with diversion. **Park Lane access will be under escort from the A452.**

Traffic management, including all signage, will be erected as and when required subject to consent, site and weather conditions. Please keep an eye out for signage on the road as dates are also subject to change as indicated above. We are working closely with SMBC to minimise disruption.

### Further information

**Local diversions will be clearly signposted.** Access for residents and businesses within the A452 closure will be maintained by approaching the traffic marshal at the relevant closure point. **For live up-to-date traffic information and diversion routes please go to [one.network](http://one.network).**

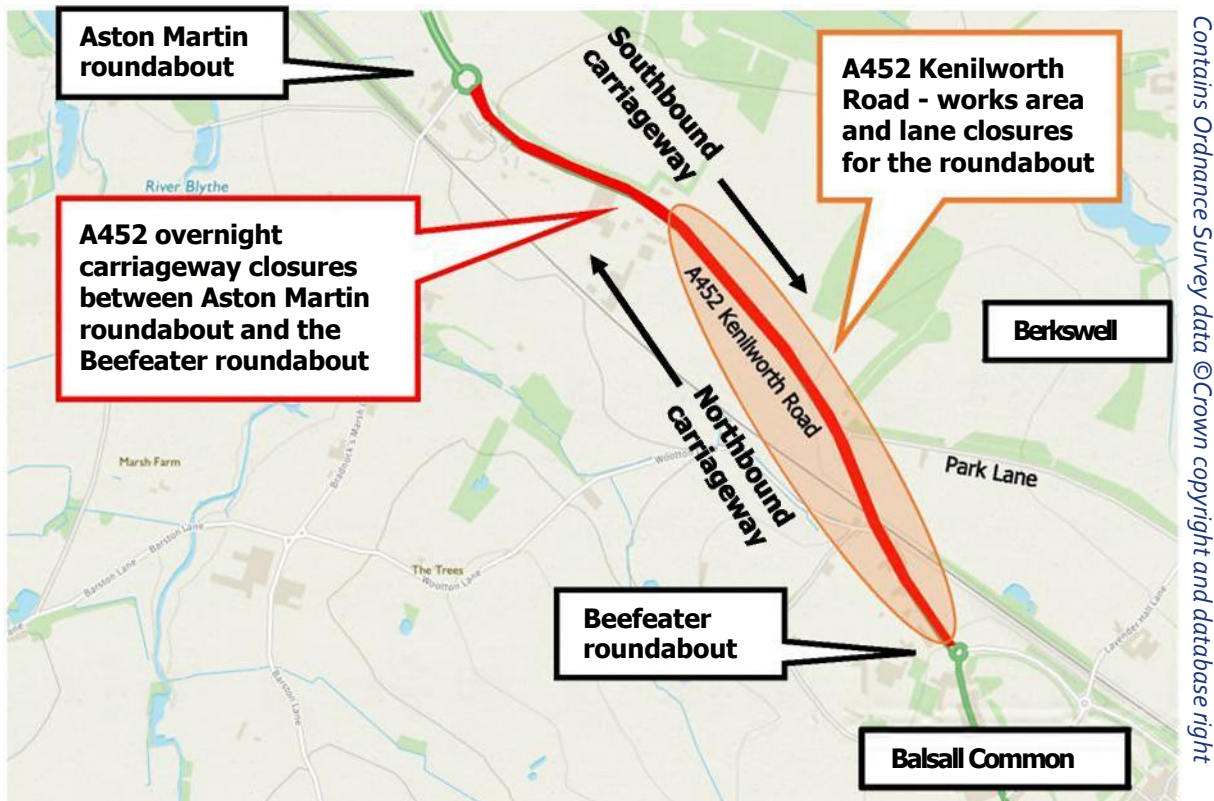
