



Main works construction update – B4114, Birmingham Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

Our works in areas near the B4114 Birmingham Road will continue throughout the rest of 2022, with our completion date in the area expected to be 2025. In this location, our works will be situated either side of B4114 Birmingham Road. We will construct a viaduct that carry the HS2 line over the B4114. Please be aware, some of these works are subject to consent.

During October, we will be completing works to create a new temporary diversion, which will involve drainage works, road construction, street lighting and signage installation. These works are expected to take place until April 2023. The temporary diversion will allow us to complete preparatory works ahead of constructing the viaduct. Please see the location on the map on page 2.

To the south of B4114, we will complete works to create a compound. The compound will include a two-storey welfare cabin and office facilities, a car park and a storage area. Initially, this will involve earthwork preparations, including topsoil stripping and haul road creation. We will also create a fourth access from the roundabout on B4114 as an additional access to our site.

We will be continuing our demolition works to the south of B4114. These works are due to be complete by the end of October, this will include salvaging heritage items by taking certain buildings down by hand.

Our working hours will be 8.00am until 6.00pm Monday until Friday and 8.00am until 1.00pm on Saturdays. Our workforce may be on site one hour before and after to set up and take down equipment. There may be times where our working hours are extended but we will notify local stakeholders about this.

We will continue to keep you updated on the programme for our future works.

What work will we be doing?

- Works to create a compound to the south of B4114
- Continued demolition works to the south of B4114
- The creation of a temporary diversion to the north of B4114

What to expect

- Our working hours will be from 8.00am until 6.00pm Monday – Friday and 8.00am until 1.00pm Saturdays
- Our workforce may be on site one hour before and after to set up and take down equipment

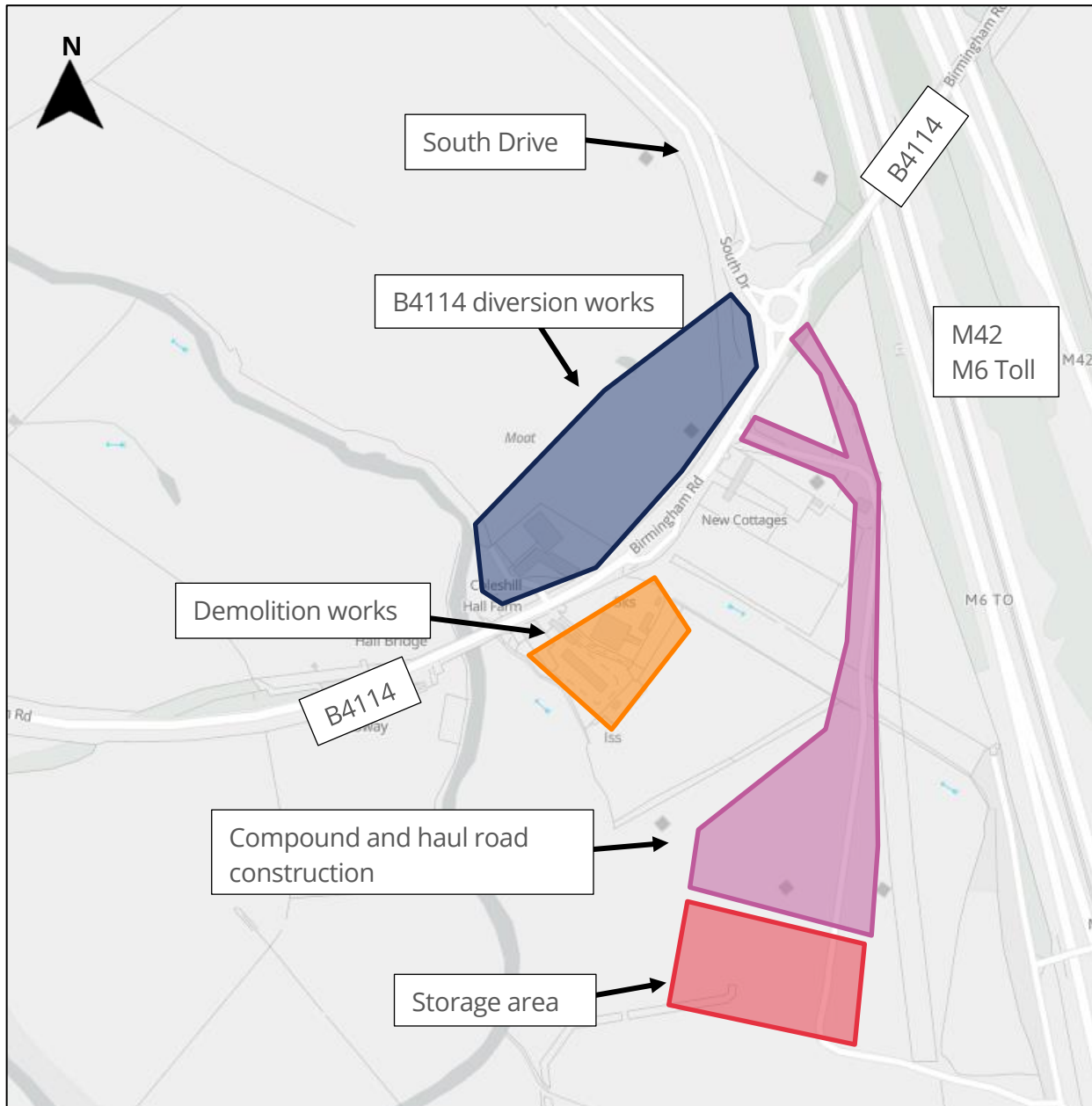

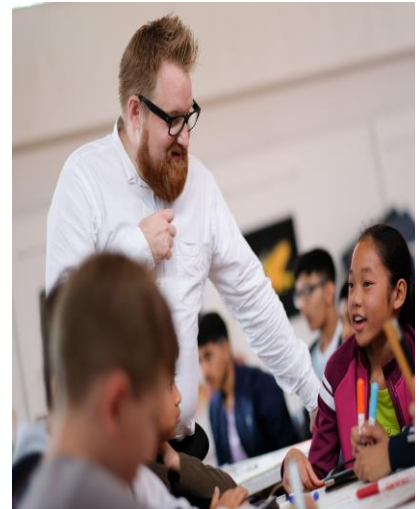
About our Community and Business Funds
