
Notice of works on Bangley Lane

The work we will be doing

We are currently constructing haul roads, safe access crossing points and surveying and diverting utilities ahead of the main works phase of the project. We recently constructed a safe crossing point on Bangley Lane and for this feature to be fully operational we must divert utilities that are located close to the site access. We will be diverting overhead power cables to ensure our working area is free from hazards. This will have no impact on residents or businesses and power will be maintained. To carry out this work safely we will create a safe working area which will require the daytime closure of Bangley Lane.

When these works will take place

The works will begin on Thursday 20 October and and will be completed by Friday 21 October. During these works we will install a temporary daytime closure of a section of Bangley Lane between 8.00am to 6.00pm (see map on page 2).

Pedestrian, equestrian and access to frontages will be maintained at all times.

Keep all sites safe and secure.


