Over the coming months, we'll be continuing to carry out work to prepare the way for High Speed 2 (HS2). To keep our staff safe, we may need to work at times that cause the least disruption to train services and passengers which can include weeknights and weekends. We're sorry if our work disturbs you. We'll make every effort to reduce disturbance where we can. We'll put noise barriers up where it is safe to do, use silenced generators and have continuous noise monitoring to ensure that noise levels are kept within agreed limits. Our staff will also be regularly briefed on the importance of working responsibly in the local community.

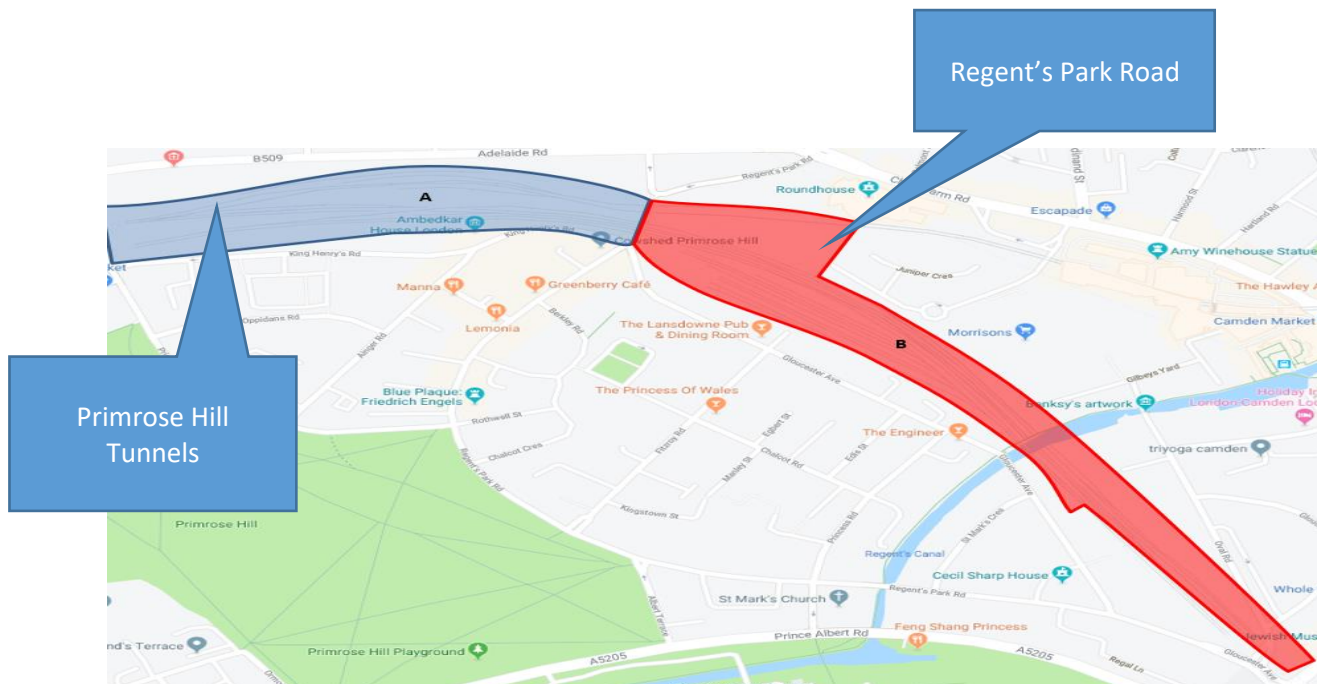

### Area A:

Dates	Working hours	Intended Work in Area A
<b>Notification Period</b> 17 - 18 December 24 - 25 December	<b>2 x Weekends</b>	<b>Network Rail Maintenance</b> We'll be replacing worn rail inside the Primrose Hill Tunnel.

### Area B:

Dates	Working hours	Intended Work in Area B
<b>Notification Period</b> 24 December 2022 29 December 2022	<b>Weekend, Midweek days, and nights</b>	<b>Network Rail – Camden Canal Bridge</b> Removal and replacement of railway infrastructure and bridge over Regents Canal.

### Area E:

Dates	Working hours	Intended Work in Area E
<b>Notification Period</b> 02 - 15 December 2022	<b>Midweek days and 2x weekend</b>	<b>HS2 Access - Clarkson Row – Track level</b> Deliver materials and equipment to site and remove scrap and waste. Investigate drainage at track level and relocate using hand tools.
28 – 29 January 2023	<b>1x Midweek night</b>	<b>HS2 Access - Clarkson Row – Track level</b> Deliver scaffolding materials by train.
23 January - 23 February 2023	<b>Midweek days and 4x weekends</b>	<b>HS2 Access – Clarkson Row – Track level and street level</b> Preparatory work for new ramp. Dates are subject to change and we'll be contacting local residents in the New Year with a full pack of information on the project
07 - 10 February 2023	<b>Midweek days</b>	<b>HS2 Access - Clarkson Row – Track level</b> Investigative trial holes will be drilled in the Euston approaches wall. The exact time of these works are yet to be confirmed but we will contact local residents with at least two weeks' notice.

22 - 28 February 2023	Midweek days	<b>HS2 Access - Clarkson Row – Track level and street level</b> Levelling track level ground and foundations for rail track and equipment. Excavation for the ramp at track level. Installation of the ramp base and frame.

Dates	Working hours	Intended Work in Area's F and G
<b>Notification Period</b> 10 - 11 December 17 - 18 December 02 - 05 January 2023	<b>2x Weekend Midweek nights</b>	<b>HS2 enabling work</b> We'll be doing some non-disruptive survey work between Hampstead Road Bridge and Euston station.
<b>Notification Period</b> 12 - 13 December 2022	<b>1 x Weekend</b>	<b>Network Rail Maintenance</b> We will be replacing worn rail between Hampstead Road Bridge and Euston station.

### Areas H:

Dates	Working hours	Intended Work in Area H
<b>Notification Period</b> 01 December 2022 – 28 February 2023	<b>Ongoing</b>	<p><b>What we are doing in Euston station – HS2 Enabling work</b></p> <p><b>Parcel deck and substation at Euston station</b> The existing structure of the parcel deck will need to be strengthened to accommodate the new substation which is being built on the east side of the parcel deck. The strengthening works will involve working above the live platforms and therefore the works can only be carried out in engineering hours, midweek nights and/or weekends.</p> <p><b>Work site areas – establishing contractors working sites and exclusion zones in and around the station</b> We will be putting up our work site areas to enable the construction work on the platforms and at our parcel deck. To keep our teams safe, we will need to do this work during engineering hours which includes midweek nights and some weekends.</p> <p><b>Our work will include</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Surveys</li> <li>• Scaffolding</li> <li>• Refurbishment work</li> <li>• Deliveries of materials</li> </ul> <p><b>Please note</b> There is scheduled 24/7 of working in this area from <b>24 December – 28 December 2022</b></p>

**Other work in your area:**

Skanska Costain STRABAG (SCS) is building the railway structures for the section of HS2 between Parkway and Hampstead Road bridge. From December 2022 to February 2023, SCS will be carrying out piling, concrete and excavation works within their worksite beside the Network Rail tracks. SCS will also continue surveys and monitoring of the bridges and retaining wall within the cutting. For safety, SCS carries out those works closest to the tracks overnight or during weekends, when the tracks are not in use.

SCS will provide local residents with advance notice of construction impacts before they begin works.
