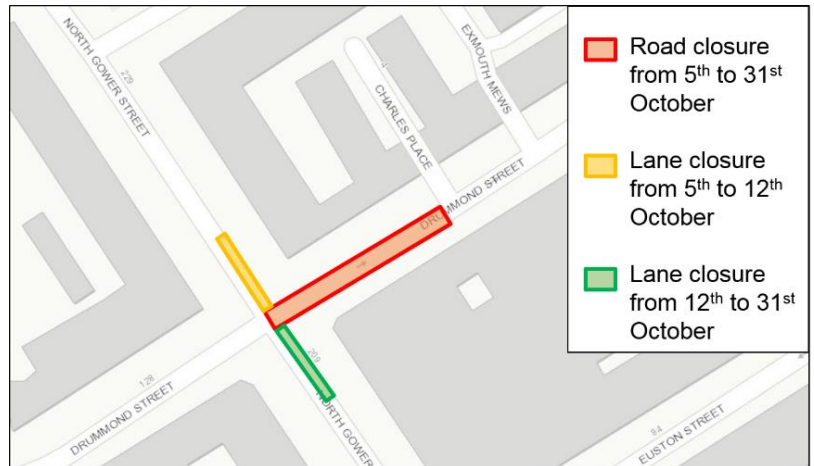

### **Power cable duct installation work – Drummond Street partial road closure**

We run the electricity network delivering power in London, the Southeast and East of England, and connect and move power cables.

On behalf of HS2, we are in the process of installing a new connection to the electricity network in the Camden area to reinforce our network. The work will involve digging a trench to install ducts that will then carry our power cable. This work should not have any impact on your electricity supply.

We are progressing through the next sections of our works in sequenced phases. From Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> October, we will require a partial road closure on Drummond Street at the junction to North Gower Street, down to the area before Charles Place. Our traffic management set up will prevent vehicular access into Drummond Street from North Gower Street, so instead will have a diversion to allow access onto Drummond Street from Cobourg Street, via Euston Street. Pedestrian access will not be affected.



Following these works, we will be returning to complete our works at the other end of Drummond Street and will require a partial road closure from the area near the junction to Cobourg Street. We will be back in contact with more details closer to the time.

We apologise for any inconvenience that may be caused by our works and will make every effort to keep the impact to your area to a minimum.
