Over the coming months we will be bringing some of the work for HS2 in the Euston area to a safe stop. There is still other vital work that needs to continue in preparation for High Speed 2 (HS2) that we cannot pause. To keep our staff safe, we may need to work at times that cause the least disruption to train services and passengers which can include weeknights and weekends. We're sorry if our work disturbs you. We'll make every effort to reduce disturbance where we can. We'll put noise barriers up where it is safe to do, use silenced generators and have continuous noise monitoring to ensure that noise levels are kept within agreed limits. Our staff will also be regularly briefed on the importance of working responsibly in the local community.



Other work in your area:

As part of the continuing Euston Station redevelopment there will be some heavy demolition work happening whilst we continue to take down the old parcel deck at the northern end of the station and make it safe to stop work. We will work closely with the contractors to mitigate the noise generated as much as we can. There will also be contractors drilling test boreholes in several areas within the Euston footprint during this notification period

Whilst major excavations to construct the Euston Approaches tunnels, concrete box and railway cutting are delayed, SCS continues work to extend Granby Terrace and Hampstead Road bridges and to prepare for tunnelling. Surveys and noise insulation installations are also continuing. HS2 has paused the new welfare building and the second lay-by planned for Park Village East. Utility works at Parkway – which will involve traffic management on Parkway, Albert Street and Delancey Street – have also been paused.
