Temporary road closures – Long Itchington Road (east)

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are now underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

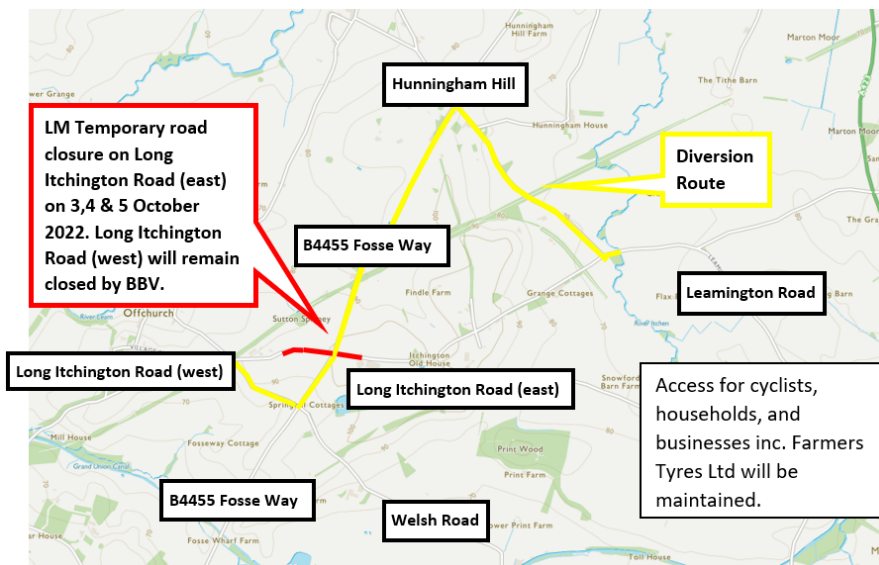
Temporary road closures on Long Itchington Road

LM will be temporarily closing a section of Long Itchington Road, east of the Fosse Way, on Monday 3, Tuesday 4 and Wednesday 5 October during off peak hours from 9:30am to 3:30pm. The reason for the closure is to create a safe working zone whilst we carry out remedial works to the cycle path kerbs and works to the drainage on this section of the road. The closure will be lifted at the end of each shift.

Access for properties and cyclists

Access will be maintained for households and businesses along the route and also for cyclists through National Cycle Route 41. A clearly signposted diversion will be in place (see map below). All works are subject to consent, site and weather conditions.

If your property frontage is within the closure points, we will work with you to manage access into and out of your property. You may sometimes experience a short delay whilst we move machinery or create a safe path within the closed area during our working hours.
