
High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be completing

We will be installing traffic management on both the M42 southbound and M42 M6 link road eastbound from Monday 10 October.

The traffic management along the M42 will be a hard shoulder closure along a short section of the southbound carriageway. (See location of traffic management on map below). This traffic management will be in place 24 hours a day from Monday 10 October until Friday 31 **March.** This will allow us to safely remove the embankment adjacent to the highway for the future M42 Coleshill Box Structure, that spans across the M42.

The traffic management along the M42 M6 link road will be an overnight eastbound closure. There will be a diversion route in place as part of this overnight closure. (See location of closure and diversion on page 2). This closure will be in place for one night on Monday 10 October, from 9.00pm until 5.00am. This will allow us to safely install of temporary vehicle barrier system.



Duration of works

- M42 M6 eastbound link road overnight closure on Monday 10 October
- M42 southbound hard shoulder closure from Monday 10 October until Friday 31 March

What to expect

- M42 M6 link road eastbound closure to be in place from 9.00pm until 5.00am
- Diversion route in place for the M42 M6 link road eastbound closure
- M42 southbound closure to be in place 24 hours a day


