

Notice of A413 daytime lane closures, Little Missenden

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As we reintroduce face to face engagement, we will continue to follow government guidance on reducing the spread of Covid-19. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. Why are you doing these works?

The central reservation outside Little Missenden site was previously used to store spoil (earth) whilst creating the turn pocket into Little Missenden site itself. During these works sediment settled here which now needs to be removed to restore the central reservation.

What will you be doing?

We will remove sediment, lay topsoil, sow grass seed and plant daffodil bulbs in the central reservation between the junction with Chalk Lane and Mop Lane and the adjacent unnamed road.

How may this affect you?

The road will remain open to traffic at all times but reduced to one lane working in both directions. Traffic management will be in place from Wednesday 21 September and Thursday 22 September from 9.30am to 3.30pm.
