

Notice of temporary traffic management, A43 update

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

What are we doing?

In December 2022, we will be receiving the delivery of large plant and equipment to our site along the A43 southbound. This equipment is required for our earthworks activities while we build the Helmdon Embankment.

In order for these deliveries to safely turn into our site, there will be temporary traffic management, in the form of a single lane closure, overnight on the A43 southbound for approximately 1 week.

There will also be temporary traffic management in the form of periodic overnight lane closures on the A43 southbound.

These lane closures will be in place to facilitate utility diversion works at our site located at the old Whitfield Racecourse and will allow for the safe exit of construction vehicles from the site. This traffic management will continue into Spring 2023.

When will these works take place?

The A43 southbound will have a lane closure between 8pm and 6am from Thursday 15 December to Tuesday 20 December 2022.

Periodic overnight lane closures will also take place on this section of the A43 southbound from November 2022 and continue into Spring 2023.

Duration of works

The A43 southbound will have traffic management from Thursday 15 December 2022 for 5 nights. There will also be periodic lane closures from November 2022 to facilitate utility diversion works.

What to expect

Overnight traffic management on the A43 southbound for the delivery of plant and machinery to our site in December.

Periodic overnight lane closures on the A43 southbound from November until Spring 2023.

What we will do

Provide updates for communities and maintain regular contact with emergency services.


