High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be completing

To inform our design of the future HS2 railway, we need to carry out surveys in the area. These surveys will include taking core samples from various carriageways, CCTV drainage surveys and trial holes. This work is to check connections between the gullies and manholes. To conduct our surveys safely, we will have temporary traffic measures in place, including a diversion route.

We will be starting work on Monday 14 November

Subject to obtaining the relevant consents, we will install temporary, overnight road closures along A446 Lichfield Road in two locations during November 2022 from 9pm to 5am each evening:

- Location 1: Monday 14 November to Thursday 17 November
- Location 2: Friday 18 November

Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after these times to set up and close down the site.

Where we will be working

The maps overleaf outline the two locations of temporary, overnight road closures along A446 Lichfield Road and the signed diversion route in place for road users. Please do not use Sat Navs but instead follow the signed diversion. Access for residents on A446 Lichfield Road will be maintained throughout.

Five nights of closures from Monday 14 November to Friday 18 November on A446 Lichfield Road in Water Orton.




Map showing Location 1 closure on A446 Lichfield Road and Watton Lane

The maps below outlines the location of the closure of the A446 and Gorsey Lane on Friday 18 November 2022.




