Old Oak Common work update September-December 2022

Update to work near you

We wrote to you back in June to let you know about the work we have planned at Old Oak Common to enable HS2. We would like to update you on some of our working hours which have had to be changed to account for access constraints and updates in the design process. To protect our work teams and to minimise disruption to rail services, these works need to take place when the railway is shut down at night or during weekend closures.
