



# Notice of A452 Southbound Closure

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area

## The work we will be doing

To build the new railway, the A452 Chester Road between the A446 and the Northway Island is being significantly remodelled. Following the successful and on time delivery of the new northbound slip road, we are now ready to commence the next phase of the work. This phase will require the southbound carriageway of the A452 to be closed from the entrance of Melbick's Garden Centre to the end of the fly over where it joins with the A446. This section of the road will be removed. Southbound traffic will be diverted up the A446 to Junction 4 of the M6 then back down the A446 re-joining the A452 at the bottom of the slip road. Please note that access to Melbick's Garden Centre will be maintained at all times via a purposely constructed central reservation crossing.

## When will these works happen?

These works will start on Monday 24 October and until Wednesday 2 November. The traffic management will be in place 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

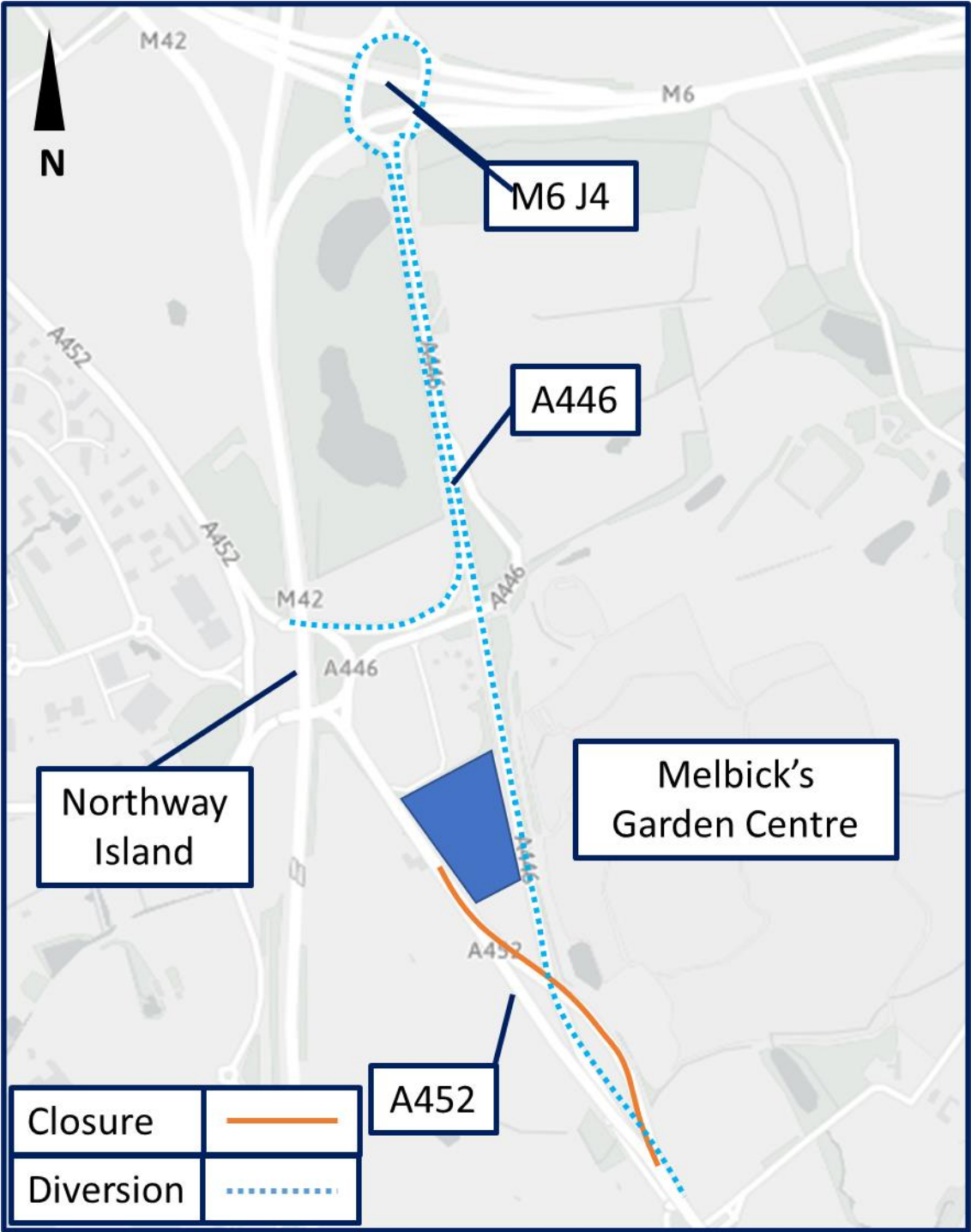

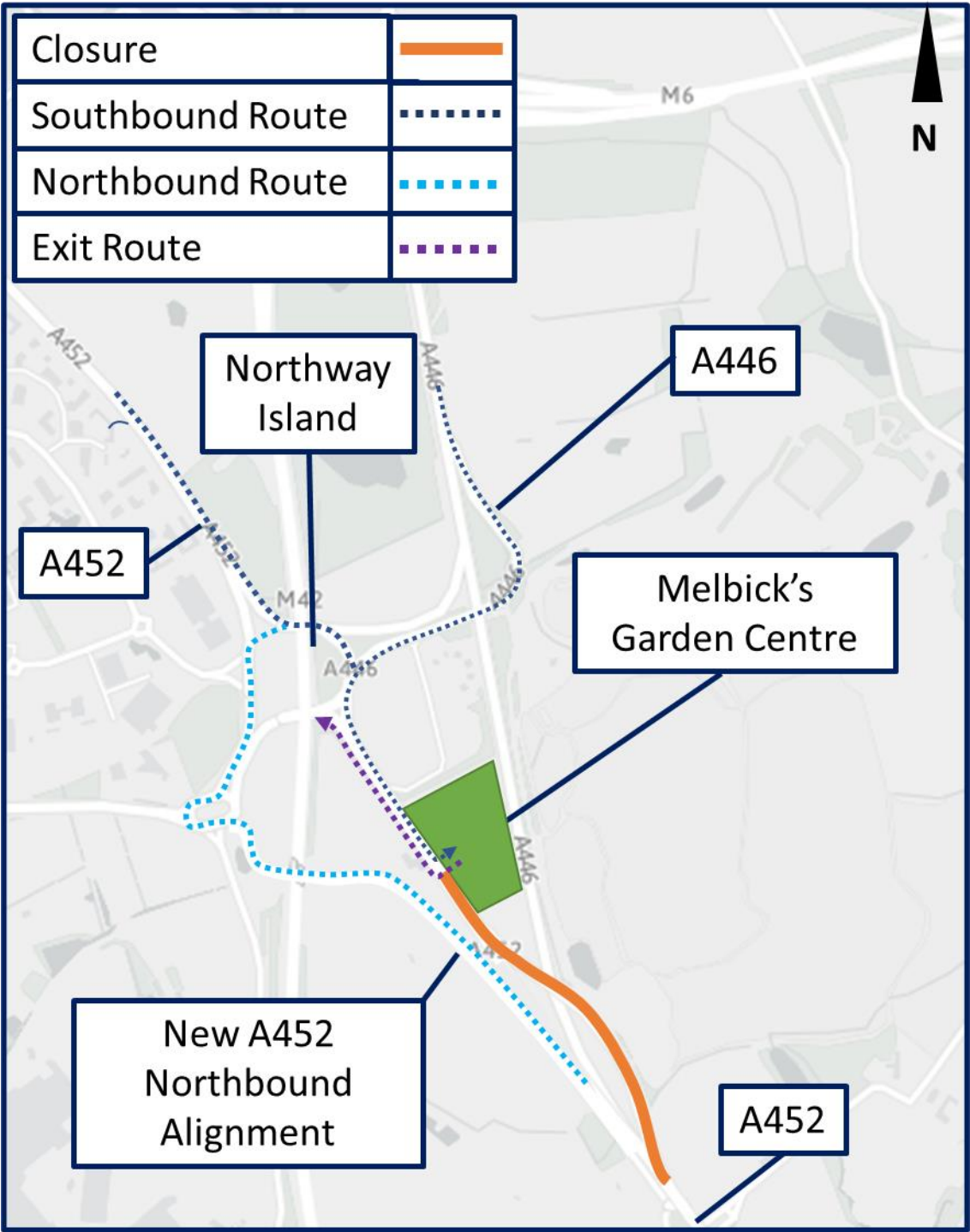
