Over the coming months, we'll be continuing to carry out work to prepare the way for High Speed 2 (HS2). In this letter I've included details of work planned between Primrose Hill tunnels and Euston station from now until November 2022. In some instances where specific shift times are still being finalised, we'll send further details ahead of disruptive work taking place.

To keep our staff safe, we may need to work at times that cause the least disruption to train services and passengers which can include weeknights and weekends. We're sorry if our work disturbs you. We'll make every effort to reduce disturbance where we can. We'll put noise barriers up where it is safe to do, use silenced generators and have continuous noise monitoring to ensure that noise levels are kept within agreed limits. Our staff will also be regularly briefed on the importance of working responsibly in the local community.

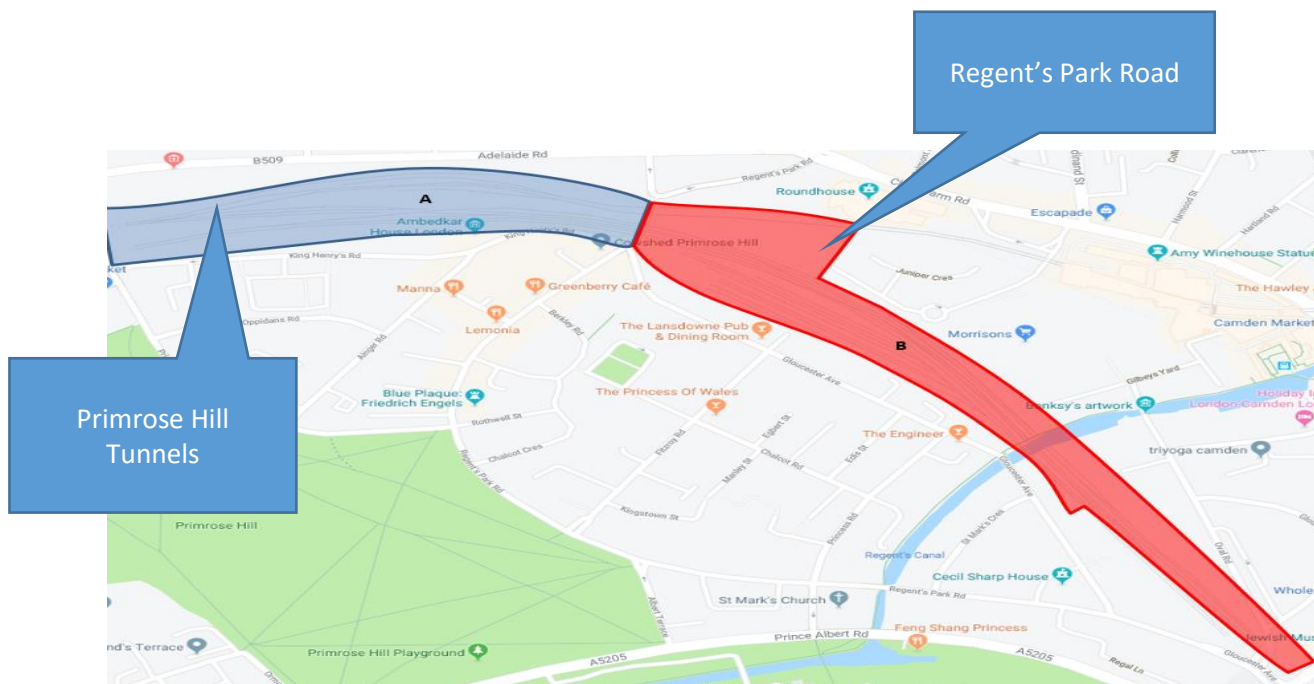

Dates	Working hours	Intended Work in Area A
Notification Period 08 October 2022 to 22 October 2022	Three Weekends	Network Rail Maintenance We will be replacing worn rail and associated processes inside Primrose Hill Tunnel.

Area E:

Notification Period 29 September 2022 to 30 November 2022	Weekends/Mid week days and nights	HS2 Access - Clarkson Row Deliver materials and equipment to site and remove scrap and waste. Preparing ground at track level for future work. Please note, The exact time of these works are yet to be confirmed but we will contact local residents with at least two weeks' notice.

Areas F and G:

Notification Period 10 September 2022 to 26 November 2022	Weekends/Mid week nights	HS2 enabling work We will be doing some non-disruptive survey work between Hampstead Road Bridge and Euston station.

Areas G and H:

Notification Period 24 September 2022 to 9 October 2022	Three Weekends	Network Rail Maintenance and HS2 enabling work We will be replacing worn rail and associated processes between Hampstead Road Bridge and Euston station. HS2 ground investigation work will take place along the tracks inside the area between Platforms 15 and 16 and leading out of Euston station.

Area H (Euston station)

Notification Period 01 September 2022 to 31 November 2022	Weekends/Mid week nights	<p>What we are doing in Euston station – HS2 Enabling work</p> <p>Strengthening work for the new substation at Euston station The existing structure of the parcel deck will need to be strengthened to accommodate the new substation which is being built on the east side of the parcel deck. The strengthening works will involve working above the live platforms and therefore the works can only be carried out in engineering hours, midweek nights and/or weekends. This work is expected to cause some minor disruption. The exact time of these works are yet to be confirmed but we will contact local residents with at least two weeks' notice.</p> <p>Work site areas – establishing contractors working sites and exclusion zones in and around the station We will be putting up our work site areas to enable the construction work on the platforms and at our parcel deck. To keep our teams safe, we will need to do this work during engineering hours which includes midweek nights and some weekends.</p> <p>Our work will include</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Surveys • Scaffolding • Use of cranes for building work <p>Alarm Testing We will need to test the evacuation alarm within the station. This will be done overnight on Saturday 10- Sunday 11 September between the hours of 01.00-04.30. We need to carry out the test whilst there are no passengers in the station.</p>

Notification Period 10 September 2022 to 01 October 2022	Weekends/Mid week nights	<p>HS2 enabling work Installation of signalling equipment at Euston Station</p>

Other work in your area:

Skanska Costain STRABAG (SCS) is building the railway structures for the section of HS2 between Parkway and Hampstead Road bridge. From September to November, SCS will be carrying out piling, concrete and excavation works within their worksite beside the Network Rail tracks. SCS will also continue surveys and monitoring of the bridges and retaining wall at track-level within the cutting. For safety, SCS carries out those works closest to the tracks overnight or during weekends, when the tracks are not in use.
