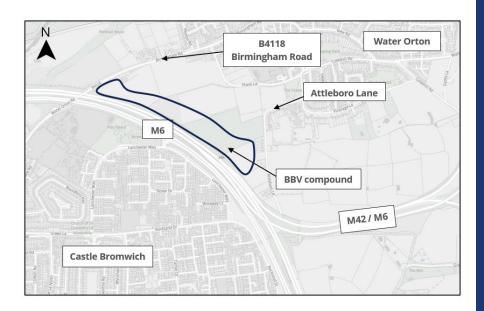


High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

Extended working hours

Since 2020 we have been setting up and working from our compound near the B4118, Birmingham Road. We will continue our construction work for the HS2 railway to pass through Water Orton by creating the Water Orton Cutting, with 24 hour working taking placed. This will include excavation and diaphragm wall works towards Attleboro Lane, which are expected to be complete by Summer 2023.

Additionally, to continue to prepare for the tunnelling, we have consent approved to extend our working hours to 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to undertake these works. As a result, there may be times where we have deliveries outside of core working hours. However, there may be occasions where our workforce will not have presence 24 hours a day on site. This work will start from Monday 14 November until Wednesday 21 December.
