

Notice of road closures, Welsh Lane and Helmdon Road, Greatworth

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

What are we doing?

In preparation for the construction of the Greatworth Green Tunnel, in late November, we will be installing some additional drainage pipes across Helmdon Road near Greatworth. This work will involve excavating the carriageway, installing the pipes and then restoring the road surface. For reasons of safety this section of road will be fully closed 24-hours a day until this work is complete. Some weekend working may be required in order to re-open the road as quickly as possible.

In addition to the above works, in early November we will be carrying out some vegetation removal along B4525 Welsh Lane near Greatworth. We are aware that road closures on this section of road can increase traffic within local villages. We have therefore planned these works using traffic lights to reduce local disruption.

Some future closures of the B4525 will be required for our construction activities and surveys. We will notify residents in advance and plan our traffic management, including closure signage, to reduce impacts wherever possible.

When will these works take place?

Traffic lights on a section of the B4525 Welsh Lane, from 8.00am – 6.00pm Monday 7 November to Friday 18 November 2022.

A full closure 24-hours a day of Helmdon Road, Greatworth, from Monday 21 November to Sunday 27 November 2022.

What to expect

Daytime traffic lights on the B4525 Welsh Lane for 5 days.

Full road closures, 24-hours a day, on Helmdon Road for 1 week.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

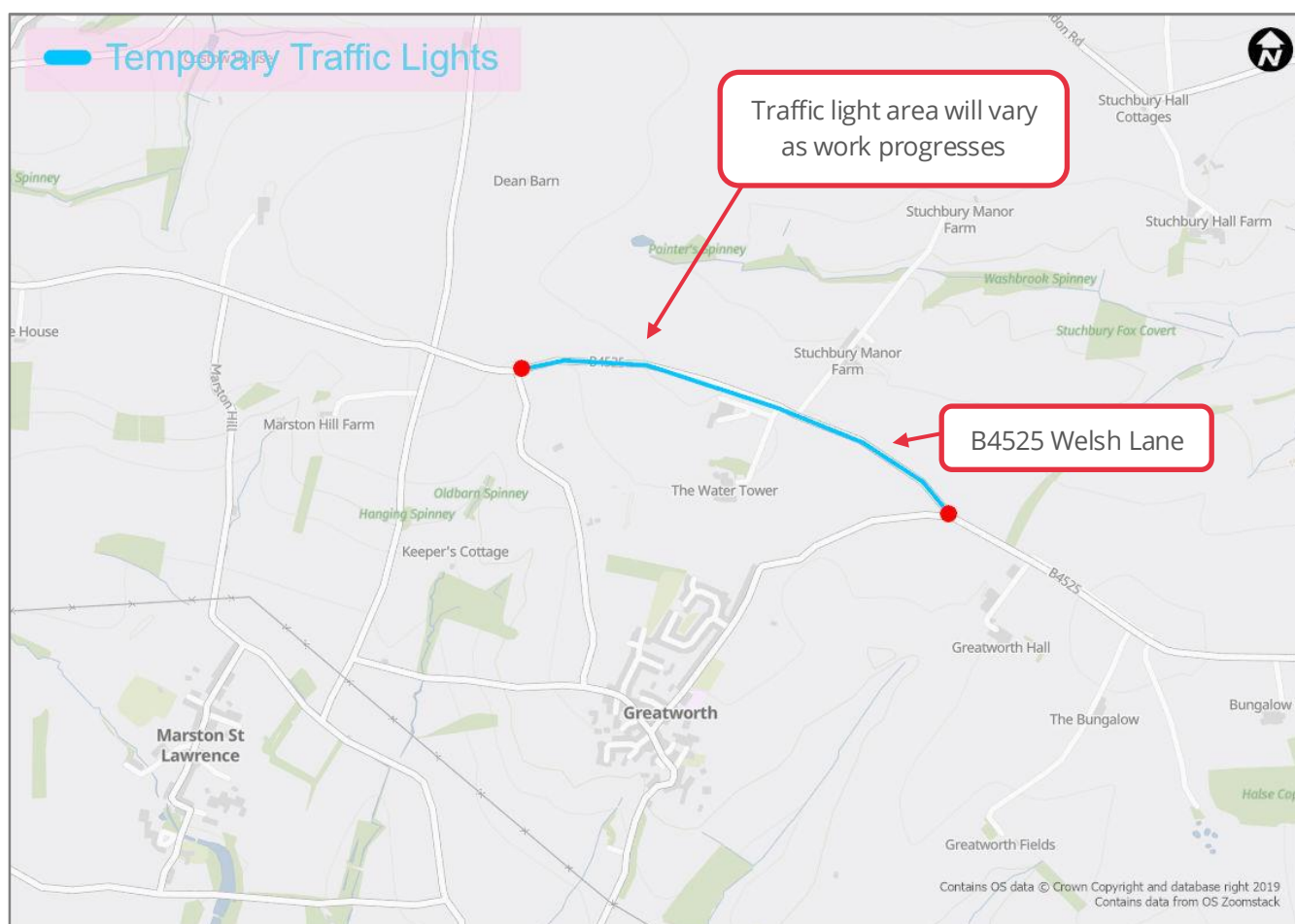
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B4525 Welsh Lane traffic light area

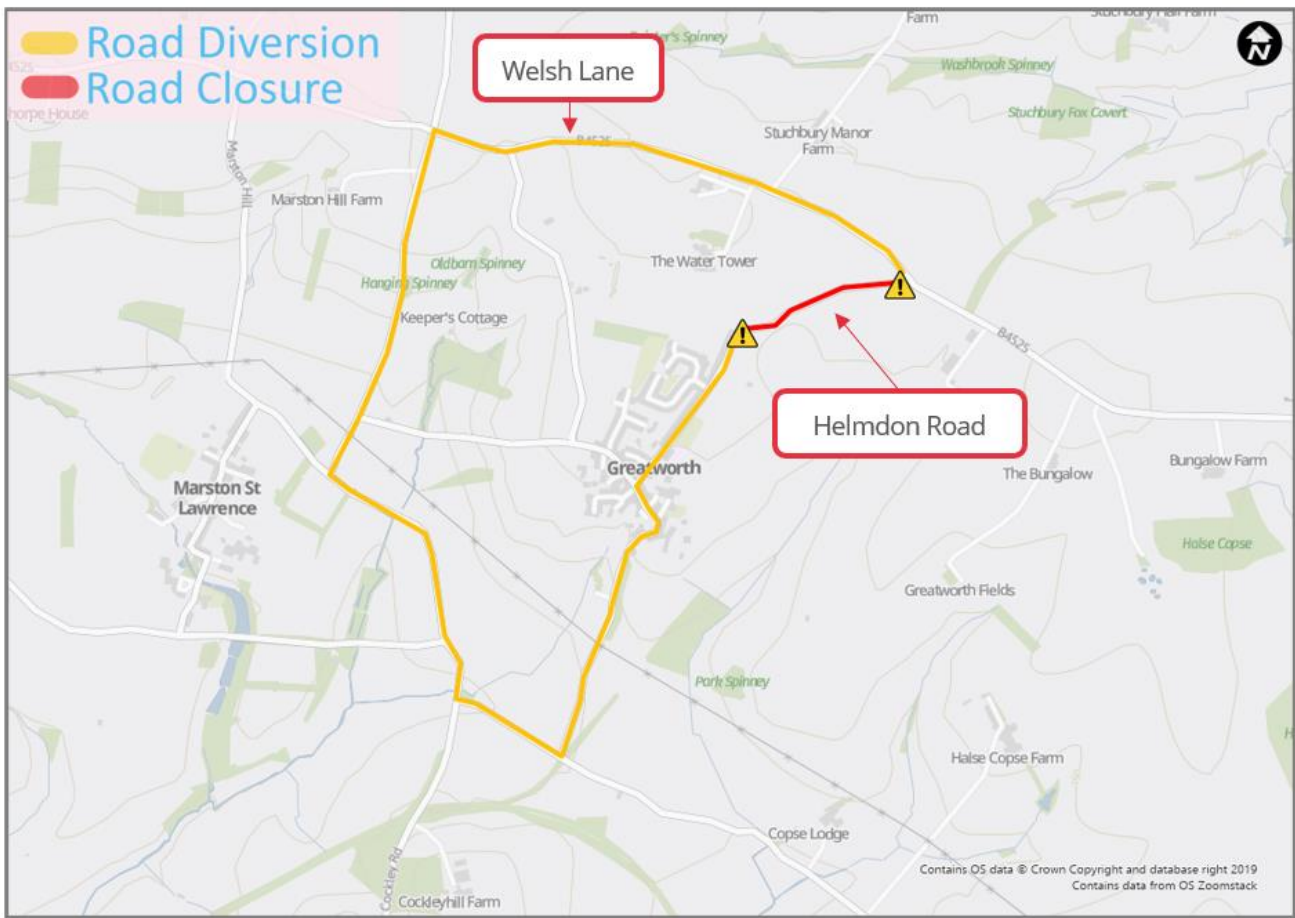
Notice of road closures near Greatworth and Thorpe Mandeville
