Notice of road closures update, Quainton

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. If you have any questions about this, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. What are we doing?

In late October and early November, we will be carrying out some urgent road repairs, utility diversion works as well as junction improvements in Quainton.

In the location between the crossroads and our site entrance, we will be conducting some minor road repairs. To help reduce our impact on the local area, these repairs will be carried out overnight and will take approximately 2 nights to complete.

Once our road repairs are complete we will then begin utility diversion works along a section of Quainton Road. As we will be working in close proximity to the highway, this section of Quaint Road will be closed during the day for approximately 1 week.

During this time period, there will also be one night where the crossroads will be fully closed for up to 3 hours while we change the junction priority through white lining as part of an accident reduction scheme.

When will these works take place?

A section of Station Road South will be fully closed overnight from the crossroads to our site entrance between 8pm to 6am, Thursday 3 November 2022 for two nights.

A section of Quainton Road will be closed during the day between 8.00am and 6.00pm from Monday 7 November to Monday 14 November 2022.

The crossroads of Station Road and Quainton Road will be shut for approximately 3 hours between 8pm and 6am for one night only, week commencing Monday 7 November 2022.

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

Duration of works

Works will commence on -

Station Road South from Thursday 3 November 2022 for two nights.

Quainton Road will be closed during the day from Monday 7 November to Monday 14 November 2022.

Station Road and Ouainton Road Crossroads will be closed for three hours for one night only, week commencing Monday 7 November 2022.

What to expect

Road closures and some additional traffic.

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods for the diversion of utilities.

Noise from plant and equipment used for the works.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

The map below, shows the section of Station Road South that will be closed between 8pm and 6am for two nights beginning Thursday 3 November with local diversion route.




