What we are doing

Overnight on 5, 6 and 7 December, we will be carrying out drainage surveys on Old Dairy Lane. The surveys will involve the use of CCTV cameras and scanning equipment in the area shown on the maps overleaf.

How these surveys might affect you

Temporary traffic management and pedestrian diversions will be in place to ensure surveys can be carried out safely. The West Mead bus stop will be suspended whilst we carry out these works. The South Ruislip Station bus stop is the nearest alternative and unaffected by these works.

We would like to apologise in advance for the disruption or inconvenience this may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way. We will ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum.

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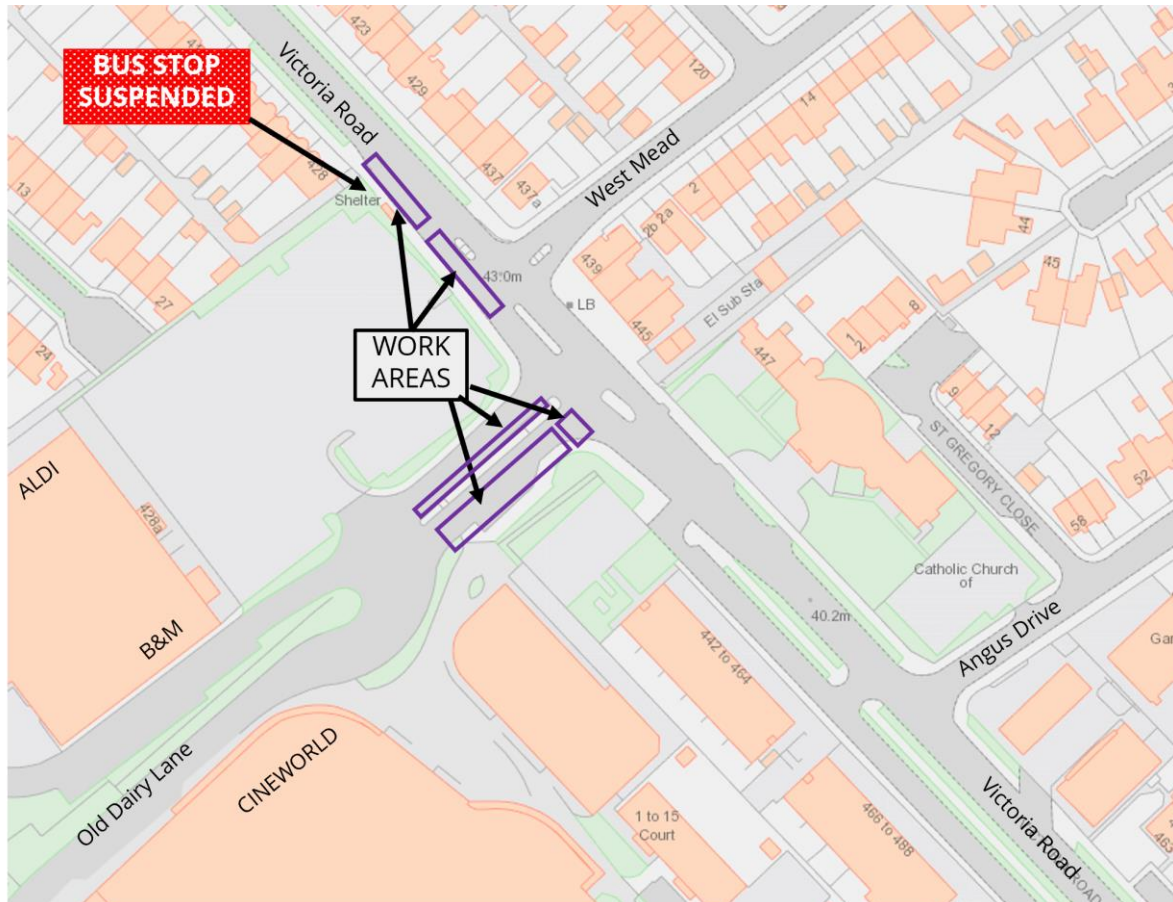
