Notice of traffic management update, A422, Westbury

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As we increase face to face engagement, in addition to virtual engagement, we will ensure all events and meetings adhere to the guidelines. What are we doing?

We are progressing with our work on the A422 and will now be completing two phases of work this autumn and winter. During the first phase, we will be working on the new temporary diversion and will be carrying out drainage and utility diversion works.

To do this safely, we will introduce temporary traffic management on the A422 in the form of two-way traffic lights during our normal working hours, Monday to Saturday. We will be monitoring the timing of the lights as well as the traffic flow on the A422. Where practical, we will make improvements and adjustments to the lights as required.

During the second phase, we will be tying in the new road and roundabout to the A422 ready for it to be opened up to traffic. These works will include the installation of lighting and signage, resurfacing and white lining.

For reasons of safety, these works will require full 24-hour road closures of the A422 in December.

When will these works take place?

The A422 will continue to have traffic management Monday to Friday from 8am to 6pm and Saturdays 8am to 1pm, as has been the case since Monday 29 August 2022, into early 2023. Where works allow, we will remove traffic management when it is not required.

A section of the A422 will be closed on the following dates:

• 8pm Saturday 10 December to 6am Tuesday 13 December 2022

Working in collaboration with Buckinghamshire Council, we have adjusted our closure dates to avoid impacting events taking place in the local area.

As a contingency should there be delays to our works, a section of the A422 will also be closed from 8pm Friday 16 December to 6am Monday 19 December 2022.

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

Daytime traffic management on the A422 and some additional traffic.

Full weekend closure of a section of the A422 in December 2022.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.



There may be a short duration outside of the advertised times to allow for our traffic management crews to set-up or take-down road signage and traffic equipment. Lane closures will not be operational during these times, however you may see our crews setting up within the highway.
