High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. What are we doing?

In early December, we will be carrying out a series of topographical surveys along the B4525 Welsh Lane and Sulgrave Road in Greatworth.

Topographical surveys will help us to finalise the design of the new railway and road alignments and where possible allow us to reinstate features after construction.

To carry out these surveys safely and effectively, we will need to put in place some short duration overnight road closures with signed diversions. This is required because our staff will be working directly on the carriageway with specialist survey equipment.

When we are working on B4525 Welsh Lane we will use a traffic management plan, to reduce the impact of non-local traffic diverting around the survey closure area.

This will include some partial road closures along a wider section of the B4525 between Brackley and Banbury. Local village access will still be available from the A422. Please see our maps on the following pages for more information on this.

When will these works take place?

A section of **Sulgrave Road** will be closed overnight, 8.00pm to 6.00am, from Thursday 1st December to Tuesday 6 December 2022, and for a single night from 8:00pm Tuesday 13 December to 6:00am Wednesday 14 December 2022.

A section of the **B4525 Welsh Lane** near Greatworth will be fully closed in both directions overnight from 8.00pm to 6.00am, from Monday 5 December to Tuesday 13 December 2022.

Partial lane closures will be in place on the B4524 at the junctions with the A43 near Brackley and A422 near Banbury, overnight from 8.00pm to 6.00am, from Monday 5 December to Tuesday 13 December 2022.

Duration of works

Works commence on Sulgrave Road Thursday 1 December to Tuesday 6 December 2022 and a single night-time closure on Tuesday 13 December.

Works will commence on the B4525 Welsh Lane Monday 5 December to Tuesday 13 December 2022.

Overnight working hours: 8.00pm – 6.00am

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Overnight road closures of in early December for topographical surveys.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services.

What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.





Where will the works take place?

When we are working on B4525 Welsh Lane, a section of the road will be closed near Greatworth. Traffic heading towards Banbury will be directed via the A43 and A422, with partial road closures at the junctions. Traffic using other sections of the B4525 will not be restricted and local village access will be available.
